Dear Rod:

This will confirm your letter on the Kulan prospecting venture. We are prepared to participate jointly with Asbestos Corporation and I will send them a letter in this regard. We won't need a formal agreement with them, unless claims are staked. We will need a prospecting agreement signed by Kulan and I enclose 4 blank forms.

I am doubtful that three months will be available for prospecting from July 25th on, and would suggest terminating the agreement at the end of September. October prospecting is dangerous and you get little value for your money out of the prospectors at this time of year. Clause 8 regarding termination, has been changed to 1 week instead of 1 month. I assume Kulan is going out alone on this trip and will not be taking a partner.

What is your understanding with regard to managing the junket? Do we pay the bills or Robinson of Asbestos Corp. I would rather we did, as we have possibly more knowledge of the area and of the Yukon curves involved in any such junket. I refer to horse deals, etc.

If the expedition is based on two months, it should cost \$500 less and some of the water will be out of it. Perhaps Kulan will insist on three months, but try for two anyway.

Don't buy any more equipment than absolutely necessary, I note you have tents, etc.
