
We have outlined on separate sketches the minimum number of claims which we feel should be retained by Vangorda Mines and Kerr Addison. In saying this we realize that there are such complications as water rights and tailings disposal problems which would arise if and when production should occur. Unless a specific claim area could be designated for tailings disposal there could be considerable disagreement later on by either party.

We do not appear to have a copy of the claim survey for Vangorda Mines and in consequence do not know how the problem of the Fin Fraction was disposed of. In any case such a Fraction is no longer included in Ted Jacka's list of claims so I presume it has been resolved some time ago. Perhaps on Ted's return he could make you a new sketch which would show more precisely the shape of the claim group adjacent to the north-west end of the Vangorda ore deposit.

I am rather surprised at Gordon Davis' statement to the effect that Turam coverage is better than gravity coverage. Davis seems to think that gravity interpretation is more difficult because of variations in the bedrock surface. He seems to have ignored the much more profound problem of variations in conductivity resulting from graphitic conductors.

Please note that in the case of the Vangorda property we have not excluded either the deposit on the Firth 6 and 8 mineral claims or the mineralized zone on the Bix # 3 mineral claims.

I presume that deletion of these zones might not have met with Mr. Davis' desire.
