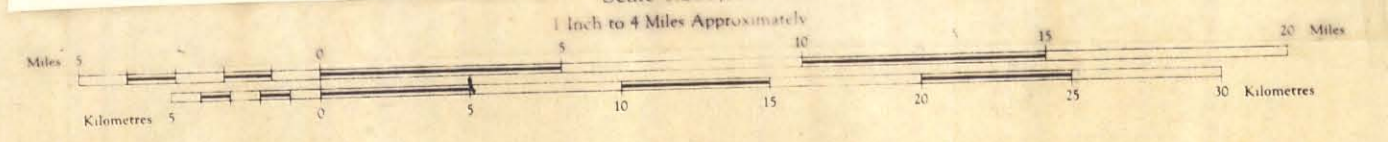


THE DECLINATION OF THE COMPASS NEEDLE 1950

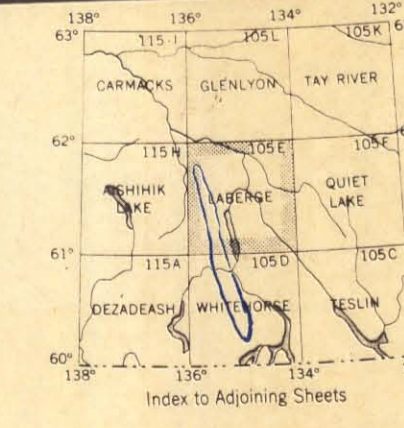

TRH Resistant, white weathering, massive limestone and thick bedded limestone; minor thin bedded argillaceous limestone. Laberge map area and Carmacks map area.

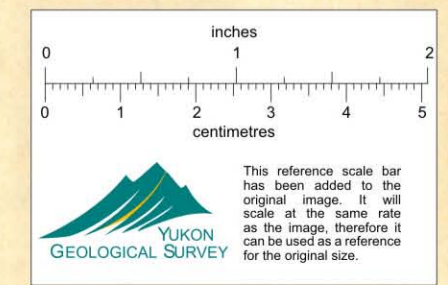
