 5 - Orange weathering, grey to pink - grey massive bedded dolomite with interbeds of shale.
 4 - Grey weathering, massive bedded medium grey dolomite, minor abundant bedded.
 3 - "Tangerine" unit.
 3b - Reddish brown weathering, unbedded sandstone and siltstone or fine sandy dolomite.
 3a - Reddish brown weathering, red to reddish brown paper bearing conglomerate with specular hematite and minor calcareous.
 2 - Light orange to tan weathering, buff dolomite and quartzite conglomerate.
 1 - Dark grey to black weathering, thin bedded, highly calcareous black shale, argillite and phyllite.
