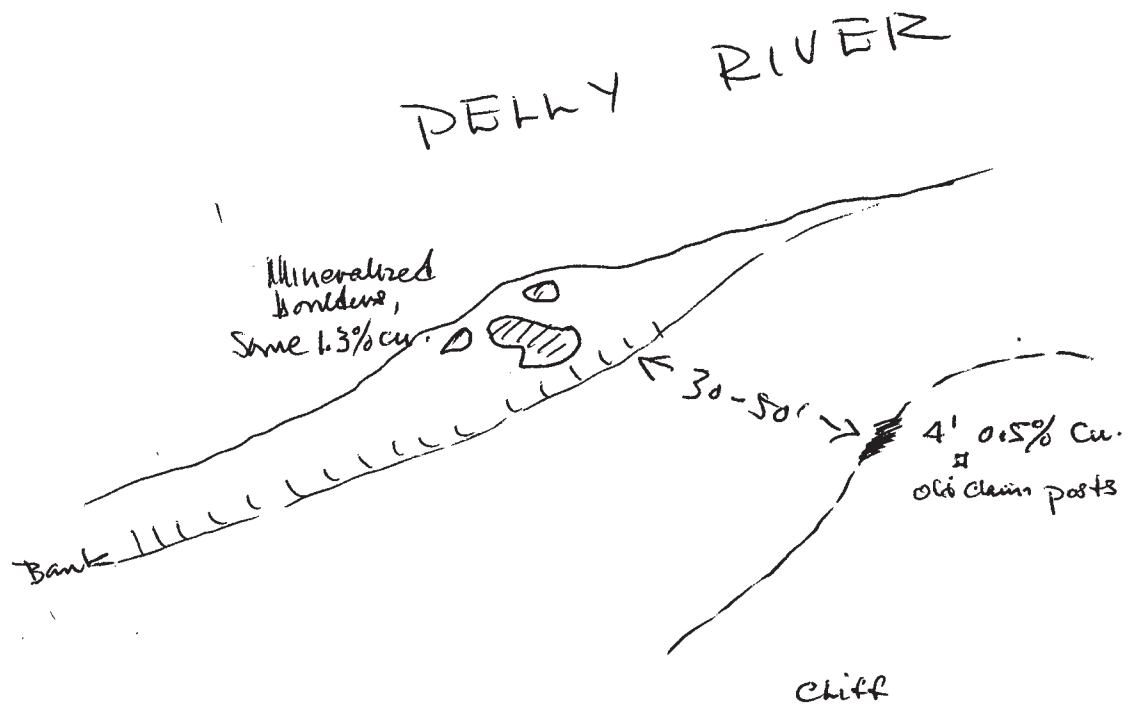
Dear Cap:

Perhaps we can get hold of a Conwest type option agreement and have something like no D.P., \$3,000 next fall (1957), \$17,000 the following fall (1958), and \$30,000 the next fall (1959), plus 100,000 shares.

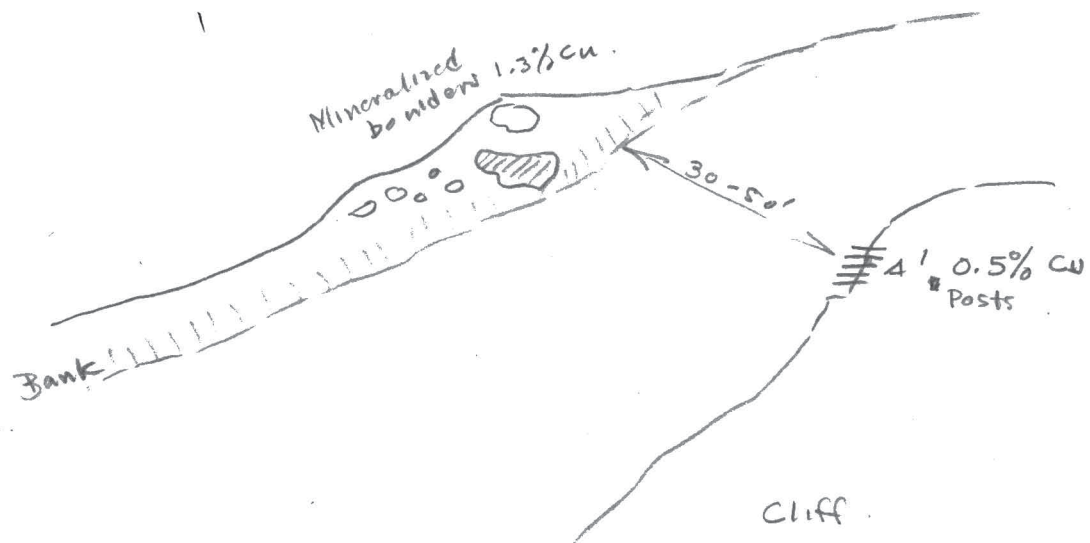
If we do find a promising mineralized zone extending under the river, it will mean drilling from the ice in winter. The river is slow enough to form good ice here.

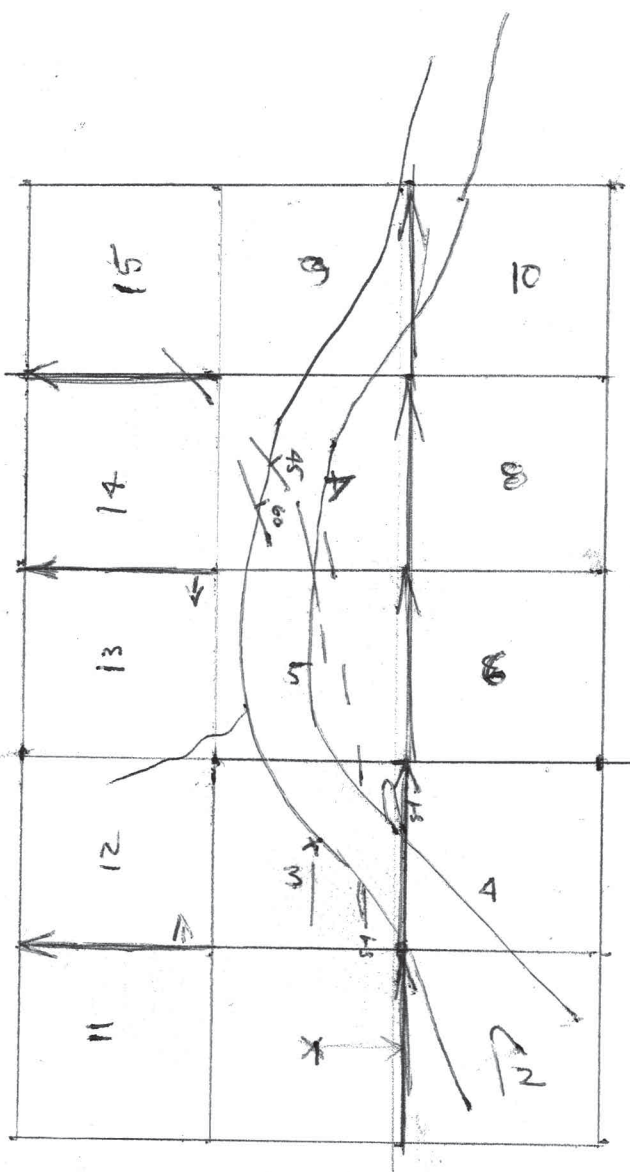


Sketch of minor copper occurrence on Delly River at Braden's Canyon.
