



THE DECLINATION OF THE COMPASS NEEDLE 1952

The declination of the compass needle at any place along a red line is the declination given on that red line. At other places the declination is between those given on the neighbouring red lines, that at the place marked A, the declination is between 31' and 32' C. The declination of the compass needle is decreasing 3' annually.
