We are interested in selling this block to any interested party following examination of the ground. I cannot give you any further information about the claims other than that there is some outcropping of the granodiorite type of intrusive.

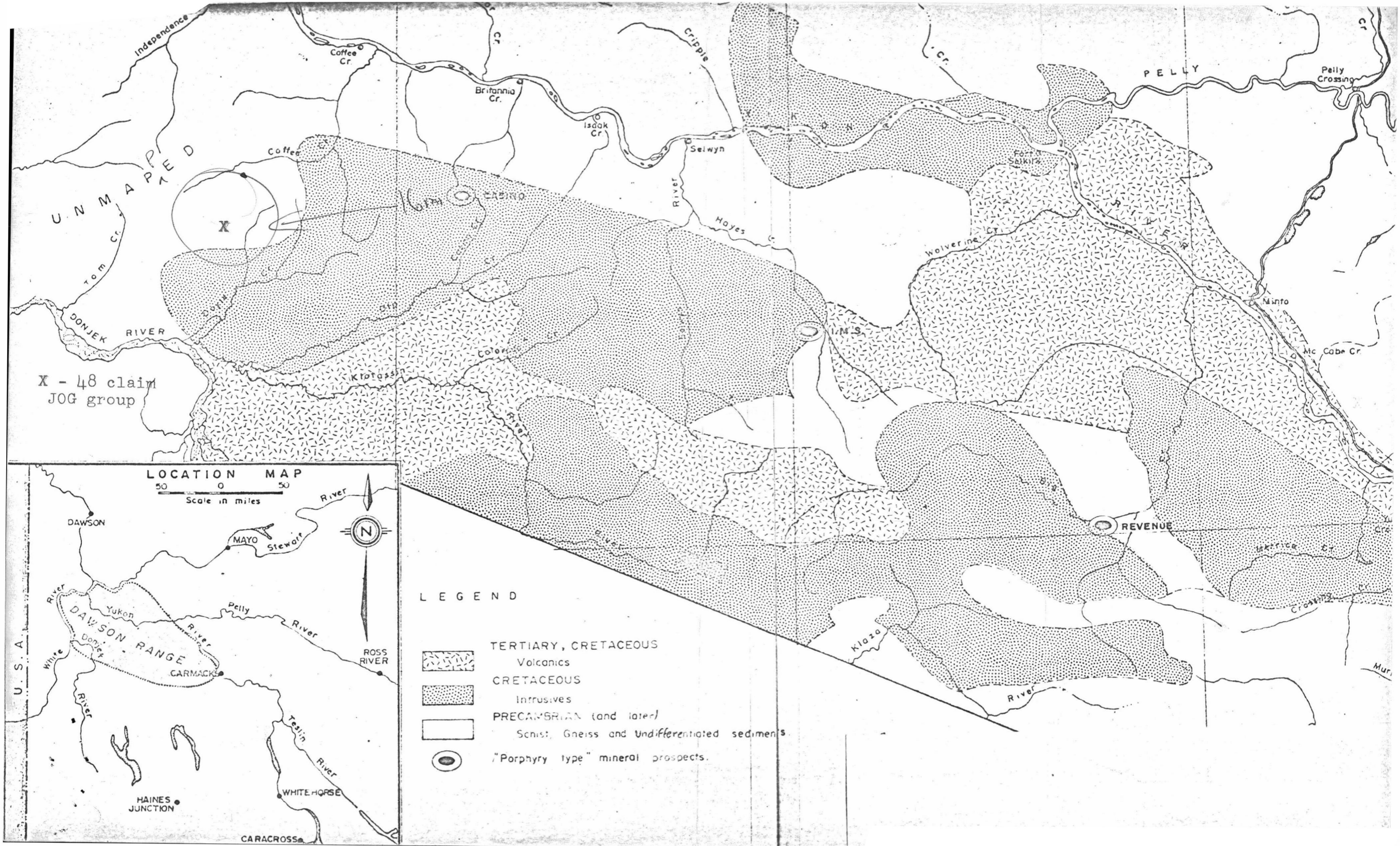
Please let me know if your company is interested in purchase of the ground, of at least in undertaking a brief examination of the ground as soon as weather permits.




