24 claims located south side Beaver Mountain northwest of Canyon City.

20% owned by Dave Small, P.O. Box 2097, Whitehorse, telephone number 667-7353, and Barry Watson.

80% owned by Pete Shear and Tony Lear, address unknown. The property is a porphyry copper situation discovered by Geophoto geologist, McGinn. McGinn located the area of mineralization during the time that Geophoto was actively engaged in regional exploration in this area. He has left the employ of Geophoto and advised the present owners of the property's location.

24 claims were staked by Small over the reported occurrence of porphyry copper mineralization. Extensive gossan is also reported over the property. Grades of grab sample material have been said to run .23 copper. The claims lie over a pronounced deromagnetic anomaly.

Small and Watson would like to participate with a company that will buy Shear and Lear's interest as a straight cash purchase. More claims would then be staked as the coverage is considered to be inadequate, and an exploration program then initiated.

Recommendations

Atlas should examine the property when snow conditions permit next year.
