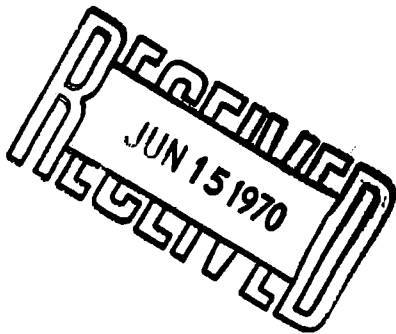


We are in receipt of your letter of May 11th regarding the Scheelite Dome tungsten property.

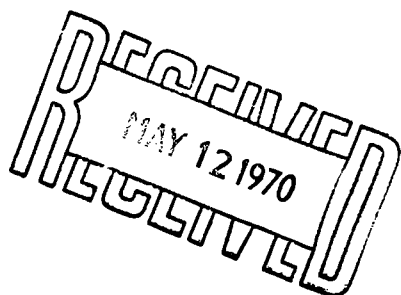
We are referring to your letter of December 19th (copy attached) in which you expressed interest in our Shceelite Dome Tungsten property.



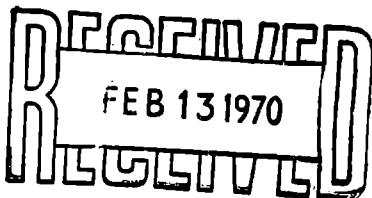
Jeff Elvins is pleased with arrangements made on December 19, 1969.

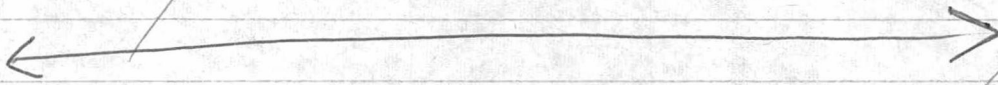


George Kazens W. Prospect-Scheelite Dome

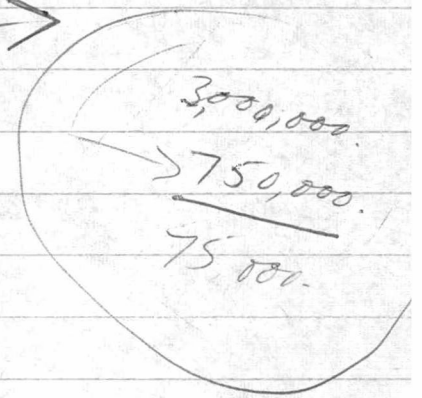


Dear George:


