Great Plains is presently soliciting participation in exploration of an optioned property in the Yukon. It is our policy to seek participation in all of our programs and we currently operate several joint ventures for major companies.

The property consists of 40 mineral claims (the BOB, KIS, GEP, RAY and GYK claims) located in the Bonnet Plume area, Yukon Territory. The property is on Harrison Creek, immediately east of the Cypress Resources claim block. The group was staked in the summer of 1973 by Barrier Reef Resources Ltd., when lead and zinc mineralization was discovered during a regional exploration project. Great Plains subsequently optioned the group early in 1974.

Work in 1973 consisted of preliminary geological mapping of the showings and the area around the showings as well as geochemical grid sampling along the inferred strike of the favorable horizon. The area along strike from the showings is almost entirely covered by overburden but the geochemical results indicate that the mineralization continues along strike. Persistence of the mineralization along strike is also supported by numerous lead-zinc showings occurring in what appears to be the same stratigraphic unit on the Cypress Resources property which borders the claim group on the west.

The program in 1974 will consist of additional prospecting, detailed geological mapping and fill-in soil sampling followed by at least 1500 feet of drilling. The program is estimated to cost \$63,000.

Great Plains is interested in acquiring a partner in this venture whereby the participant would supply one-half of the exploration costs to earn 50% of Great Plains interest in the property. The proposed agreement is by no means inflexible and alternate proposals would be entertained.

I will be contacting you shortly to see if your company has any interest in this venture. If you are interested it would be arranged for you to review the available data and to examine the property if desired.
