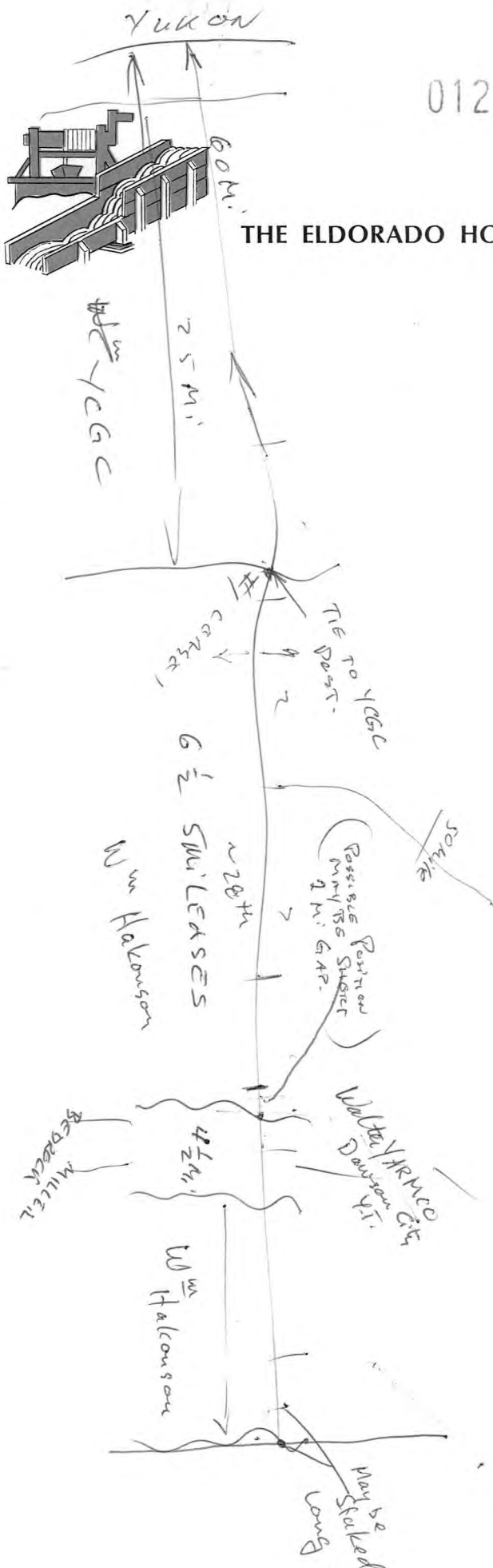

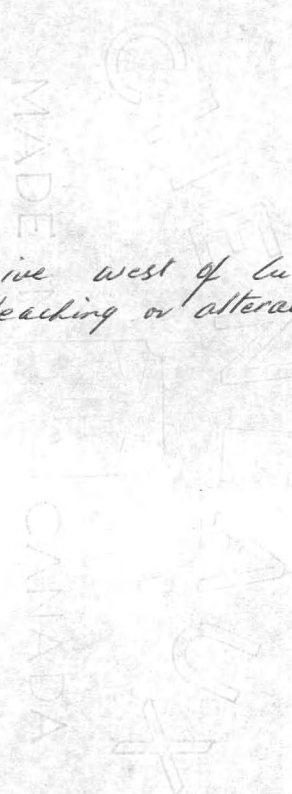

Gentlemen:

A group consisting of myself and several other gentlemen has acquired forty contingency miles of placer gold claim leases on the north fork of the Ladue River. These are staked and recorded in Dawson City District, Dawson City, Yukon.

While no test samples have been drilled, several of the persons in my group have had prior mining experience and these leases were acquired only after considerable planning, research and detailed knowledge of this valley.

One of the persons in this group is particularly qualified and has trapped, mined and prospected the north country for over thirty years. He is Mr. Sam Espland and it is his opinion that this ground has excellent prospects for placer gold and that its formation is similar to that of the Klondike River. The creeks that run into the north fork of the Ladue River especially show good prospects. Mr. Espland's other qualifications include the fact that he prospected for the Treadwell Yukon Company for seven years. I would also point out that you might wish to refer to the geological report by W. E. Cockfield, "Sixty Mile and Ladue Rivers Area, Yukon" which concludes that this ground shows very favorable for placer and quartz mining.

Would your company be interested in exploring and mining these gold placer claims?
