SUBJECT: Presentation of a Property by J. Barry O'Neill

A nickel-copper showing on Dickson creek about 10 miles west of the Alaska highway at Mile 1070 near Kluane Lake has recently been staked by J. Barry O'Neill of Whitehorse.

Mr. O'Neill describes it as an occurrence of peridotite and other ultra basic rocks with pyrrhotite present in a zone 135 feet wide. Channel samples were said to grade about .3% Ni and .3% Cu. These samples were taken by Len White for Carl Springer's interests in about 1953 at about which time the showings were first discovered and staked. Minimal work was recommended at that time but the claims were allowed to lapse. The ground had been open until staked by O'Neill recently. Thirty-two claims were put in.

The showing is marked on G.S.C. Map 19-1958 which accompanies paper 58-9 by J. E. Muller (1958) but is not specifically mentioned in the report.

It appears to be at an elevation of around 5000 feet.

O'Neill is interested in having this property examined by members of the Atlas staff.
