With respect to your enquiry regarding
locations of assays that appear on page 9 of the 1970
Max Group Report:

- Sample Y1307 - Is a grab sample taken July 6th on the
Max claims from a gossan area designated
as EM #1 and noted as a rusty gossan con-
taining 2-5% chalcopyrite with pyrrhotite
and pyrite. I think this area is between
Lines 40 and 48W, near Rhyolite Creek.
- Sample Y1308 - Is a grab sample designated as EM #2 in
altered micaceous quartzite with silicification
containing up to 1% chalcopyrite, pyrrhotite
and pyrite.
- Sample Y1309 - Is designated as EM #3 and is a grab sample
from the same location as EM #2.
The exact location of EM #2 and #3 has not
yet been determined.
- Sample Y9717 - Is from a grey to white dike rock near
quartzite skarn on the old Max #1 grid
line 44W 2+00S.
- Sample Y1301 - Is a grab sample of metallic grey mineral
in quartzite noted as occurring over one-
quarter mile. Location unknown.
