History and Previous Work:

Pike and Scott Simpson, who was in charge of the HBC post at Sylvester Landing, made a prospecting trip during the winter of 1892-3 to the Upper Canyon of the Hyland River and staked claims.

Description:

They found a "ledge of blue quartz" and later learned "that these specimens proved to be fairly rich in silver and to contain a little gold". This showing could be related to the placer gold downstream and, in fact, could actually be situated in the lower canyon, near the head of the placer.
