Description of Showings (To accompany figure 1)

Area 1:

- A. A shallow trench 90 feet north of creek exposed 6 feet of well mineralized siderite.
- B. A 10' x 18' outcrop mineralized with chalcopyrite is exposed on the south bank of the creek.
- C. 20' width of siderite containing chalcopyrite exposed by cut bank of the Black River.
- D. Outcrop exposed by low water for 275' along the Black River.
- E. Scattered quartz-calcite stringers in phyllite poorly exposed over a 500' distance.

Area 2:

- A. Siderite outcrop 110 feet by 32 feet. A blasted face of the lower end reveals high grade copper mineralization.
- B. A series of quartz-calcite stringers in the phyllites.

Area 3:

Siderite outcrop on the bank of the Black River.

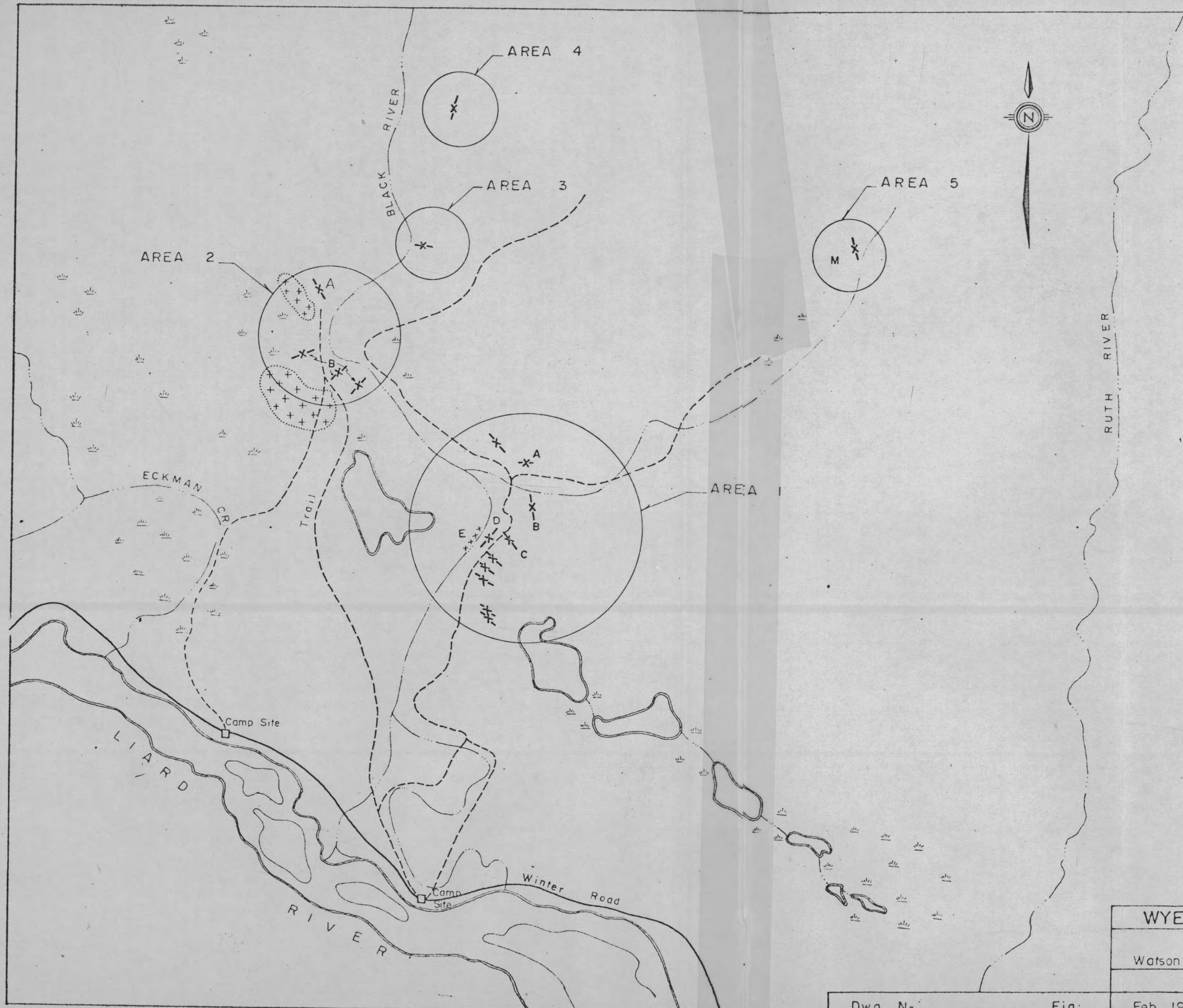
Area 4:

Siderite outcrop on the claim line between claims 7 & 8. 850 feet NE of the Black River.

Area 5:

Weakly mineralized siderite exposure near the head of the tributary creek on the eastern part of the claim area.

Grab samples from areas 1 to 4 were taken by Mr. T. Flint to represent the character of exposed mineralization with no volume implied. Analysis by Whitehorse Assay Office, Nov. 19, 1969, Certificate No. 5860-10.
