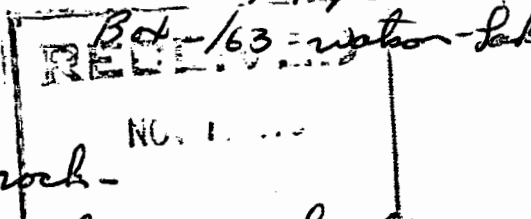

Dear Andy,

That was indeed a forbidding morning that we decided to look at your Rancheria property. I drove through about 6 inches of snow in the vicinity of Mile 710 on my way back to Whitehorse.

The samples of galena which I had assayed for you proved to have an Ag oz.T/Pb% ratio of less than 1; subsequently, we do not feel that it could be a profitable high-grade situation (A copy of the assay is enclosed).

John Brock has informed me that you have additional showings which may be of interest to us.

1. Bornite-silver showing in the Mickne-Finlayson Lake Area.
2. Asbestos showing with 4 inch thick seams of chrysotile.
3. A lode gold occurrence near the headwaters of the Pelly River.

If you could give me some further information on these occurrences (i.e. latitude and longitude of the occurrences, number of claims staked, any assays, or reports you may have, samples etc.) it would help me in my preliminary studies.

We are still interested in your occurrence near the Ross River road and 90 miles north of Whitehorse. As soon as an examination is possible in the spring we would like to set an examination date with you.

Hope you have a good winter.

PROPERTY SUBMITTED - Francis Lake Area - 105-H

Submitted by Andy Szabo, c/o General Delivery, Watson Lake.

A sample of copper, zinc sulfide with pyrotite in a hornblende skarn was submitted by Andy Szabo. The occurrence is described as being 115 ft. long and 10 miles off the Ross River road 90 miles north of Whitehorse. The area is not staked. Assays are as attached.

As snow conditions did not permit the examination this year, Szabo should be contacted for an examination as early as possible in 1971. Szabo also has several other properties in this area:

1. Mickne Lake - Finlayson Lake Area - bornite silver showing. Was once staked by John O'Neil - 48 claims.
2. Asbestos showing of 4 or 5 inch thick seams of cryptolite.
3. Lode gold occurrence at the Head of Pelly River.

Further details should be obtained from Szabo and these examined if feasible.
