Mr. Ray Hrkac of Pine Lake Mining Co. Ltd., 615 West Pender, Vancouver, B. C., telephoned me the other day regarding copper showings that they were exploring on the east side of Lac LaBarge about 25 miles north of Whitehorse. I made a few sketchy notes during the telephone call and, I believe, left them with other notes which you have in a stack of papers. If not, the situation is essentially as follows:

Pine Lake Mining Co. Ltd., under Hrkac and Ken Sanders, have explored and drilled several skarn-type copper showings in the limestone series next to porphyry intrusives on the east side of Lac LaBarge and have discovered that in their drill holes they have gone into altered porphyry with disseminated mineralization and also traces of molybdenum. The main area may be some 2000 feet in extent, assumed to dip in limestones, and they would like to have us join them in doing other detailed geophysics and/or recce. type exploration to explore the potential of these deposits or of the mineralized district which they believe to be more widespread.

I think this occurrence is interesting enough that it may warrant examination; or at least consideration by yourself or another of our personnel, and I trust that you will be able to contact Mr. Hrkac either upon your return to Vancouver from Alaska, or in the subsequent near future.
