Re: Hitchhiker Claims

One of our senior geologists, Tom Adamson, made a brief examination of the Hitchhiker showings on September 5th, 1975. Despite some snow, Tom got a fair idea of the distribution of mineralization. He reports numerous small, irregular zones of skarny lead-zinc mineralization, in fractures, in a limestone unit adjacent to acid intrusive. He suggests the showings are too small and discontinuous to be of interest.

As the claims lapsed in 1974 obviously no work could be filed and there did not seem much point in staking claims on the basis of what could be seen on surface.

I enclose your original airborne compilation as requested. I regret that the ground does not appear to hold any more promise than the numerous small skarn occurrences discussed at our first meeting but we thank you for the opportunity to examine the property.




