REPLY LOOKING FORWARD TO SEEING YOU BEERIE TOO LONG.



Dear Al:

I have put together in some haste the information I feel to be pertinent to your exploration planning. Areas of interest appear on the Lansing, Niddery Lake, Frances Lake and Tay River map sheets.

As I have indicated several times verbally I feel the altered zone adjacent to the granite in the S. W. corner of the Tay River Sheet deserves some detailed geophysical study. The gossan zone that appears most interesting in this belt is the one north of the Magundy, it is circled in red.

On the Niddery Lake sheet there is a high Pb value in the creek N. E. of the Tan Group. Perhaps a tie on in this direction would be good business. Sample 5 on this sheet is also of interest, it comes from a briefly visited gossan in a cirque adjacent to a granite. It is an area that should be kept in mind for the future.

On the Lansing sheet these values are associated with the granites in the area, and the meaning of these will have to await more detailed prospecting. When in this area the skarn type Cu mineralization was all that was noted.
