



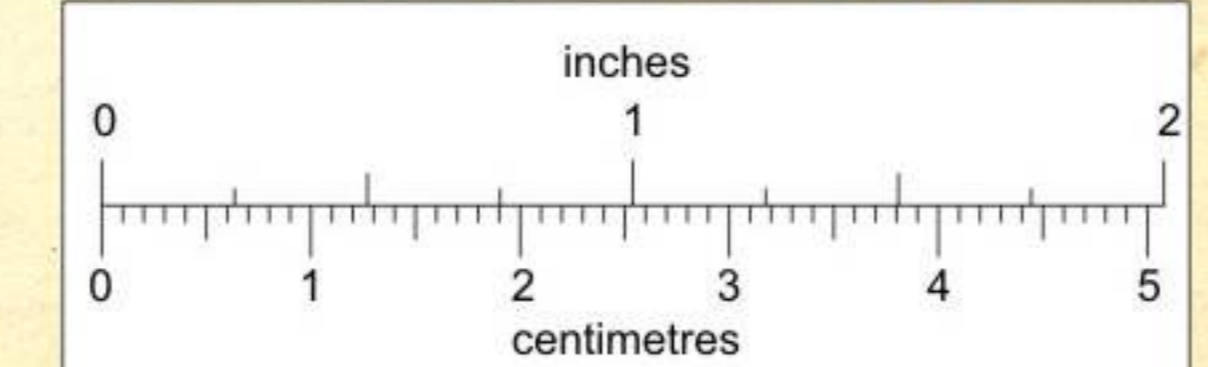
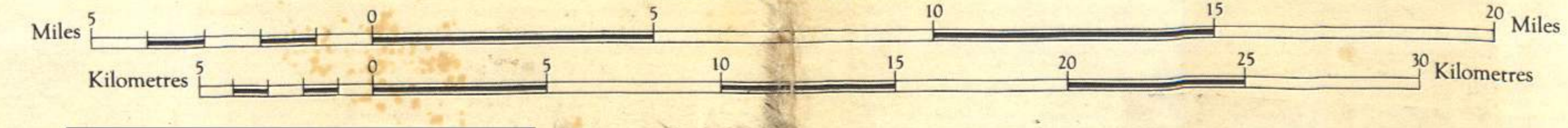
THE DECLINATION OF THE COMPASS NEEDLE, 1952

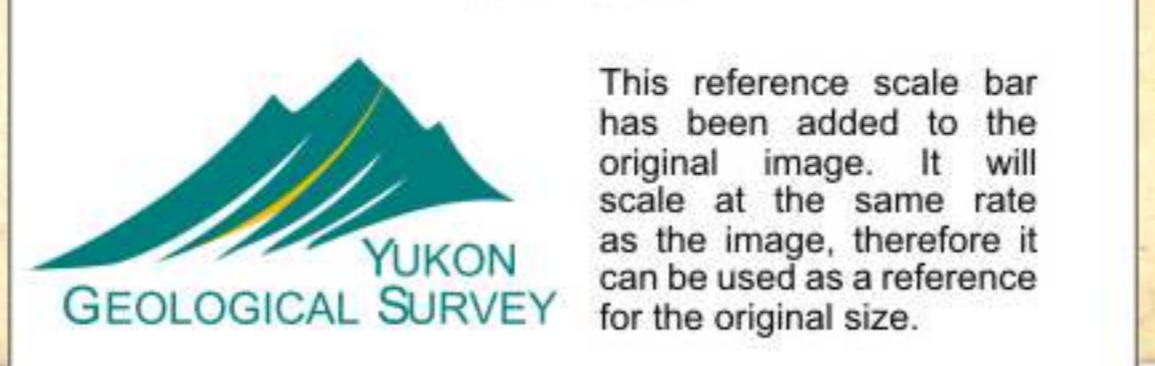
FINLAYSON LAKE

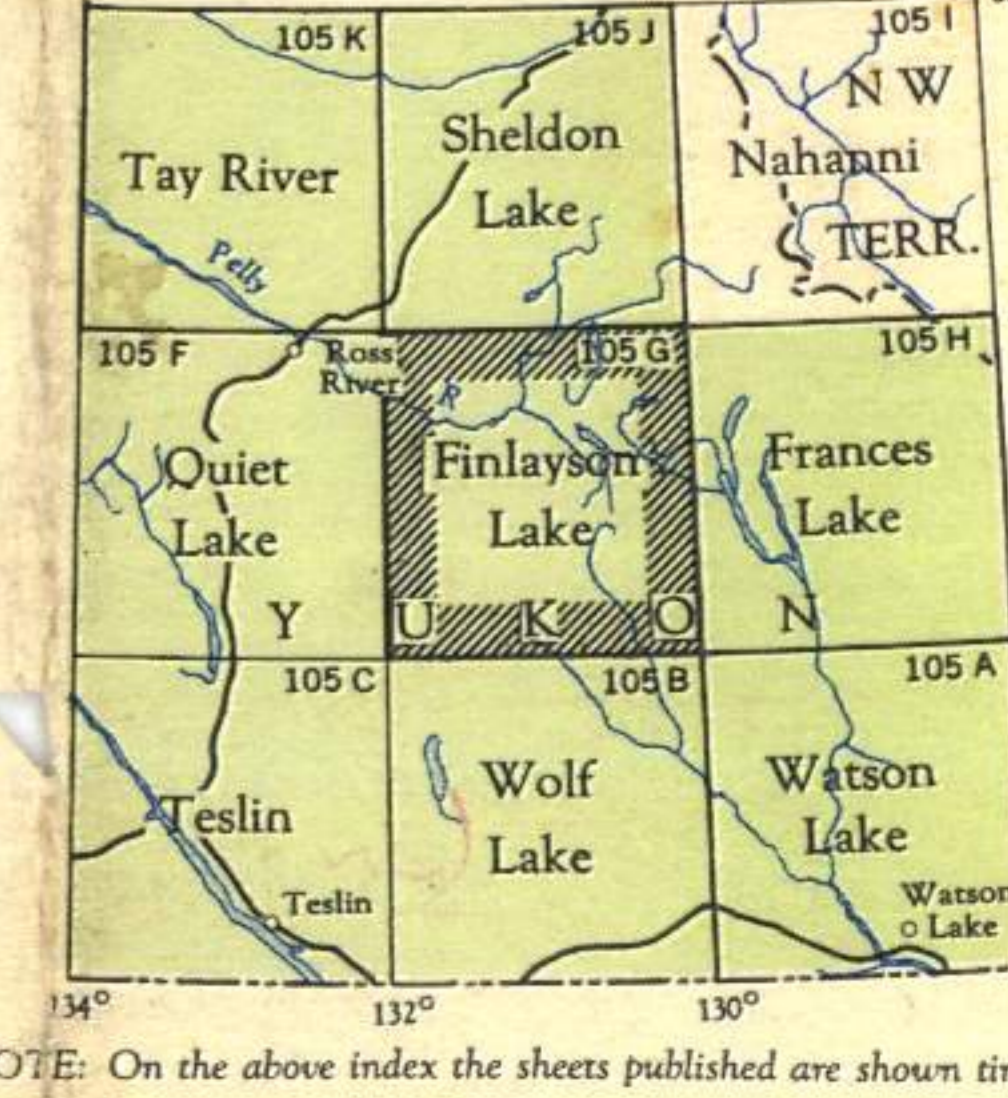
