EXAMINATION REPORT: 'Romfo' Gossan Area

Location: Finlayson Lake Sheet, Yukon Territory, approximately 52 air miles south southeast of Ross River and 8 miles northeast of McNeil Lakes.

Presented by: Lloyd Romfo,
1020, 50 B Street,
Ladner, B.C.

Particulars: Through the courtesy of Lloyd Romfo, an area of reported gossan by Romfo, was flown over August 1st. A fixed wing aircraft on floats was provided by Romfo for the purposes of an aerial reconnaissance.

Three gossans of major significance were located, shown as 'A', 'B', and 'C' on the accompanying sketches. All occur on a west facing slope at elevations of approximately 4500 to 5000 feet. All are well exposed and appear to be of extensive, massive dark limonitic material. It appears that each gossan occurs in unit (6a) as mapped by the GSC; partly altered volcanic rocks, greenstone, meta-diorite, minor serpentine and amphibolite. There are no aeromagnetic anomalies immediately associated with the gossan occurrences (ref GSC aeromag). The rock units of the area were not determined from the air, however it is thought that there may be schistose formations present. 'A' gossan is the smallest, being some 100 x 200 feet in dimension. 'B' gossan is the largest, 100 x 300 feet and appears to be of thicknesses up to 6 feet, in certain sections it is almost black in colour, some transport by local drainage is evident. 'C' is of similar dimensions but a lighter brown in colour.

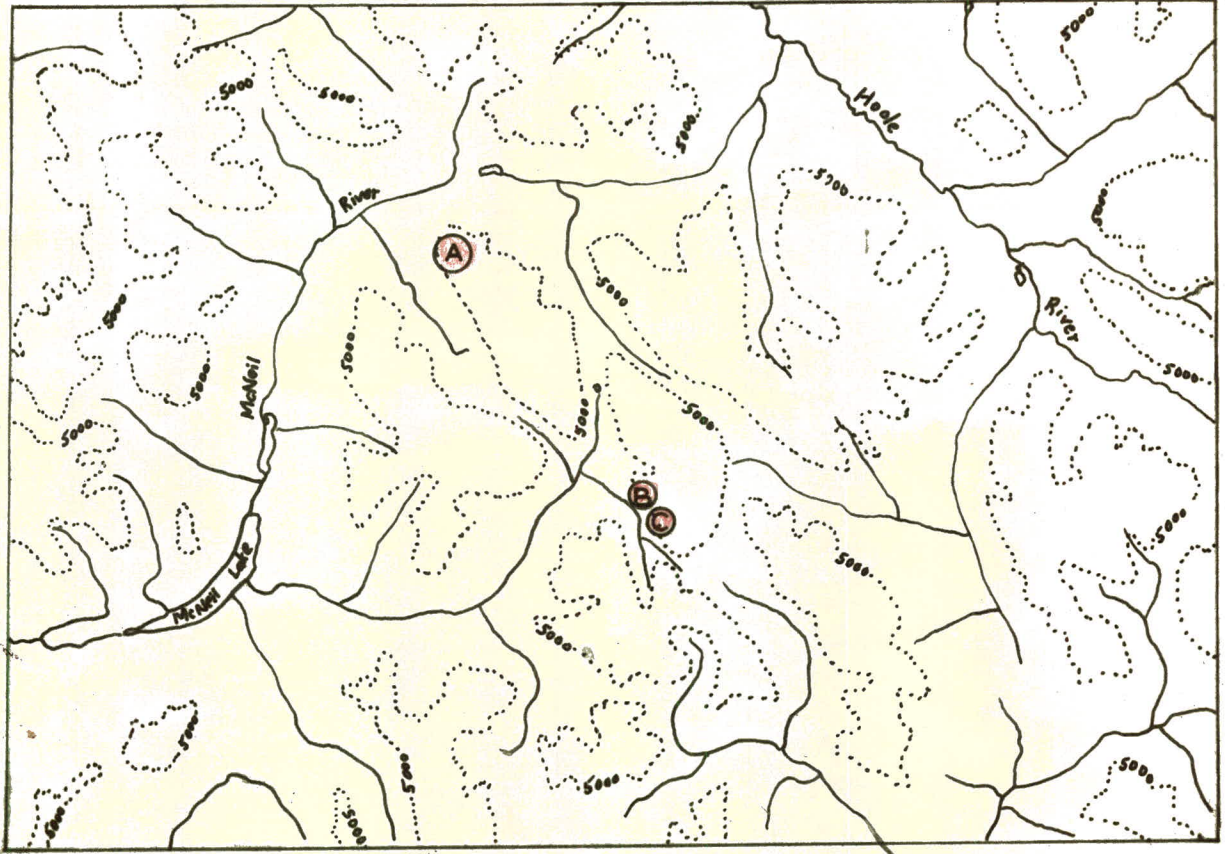


