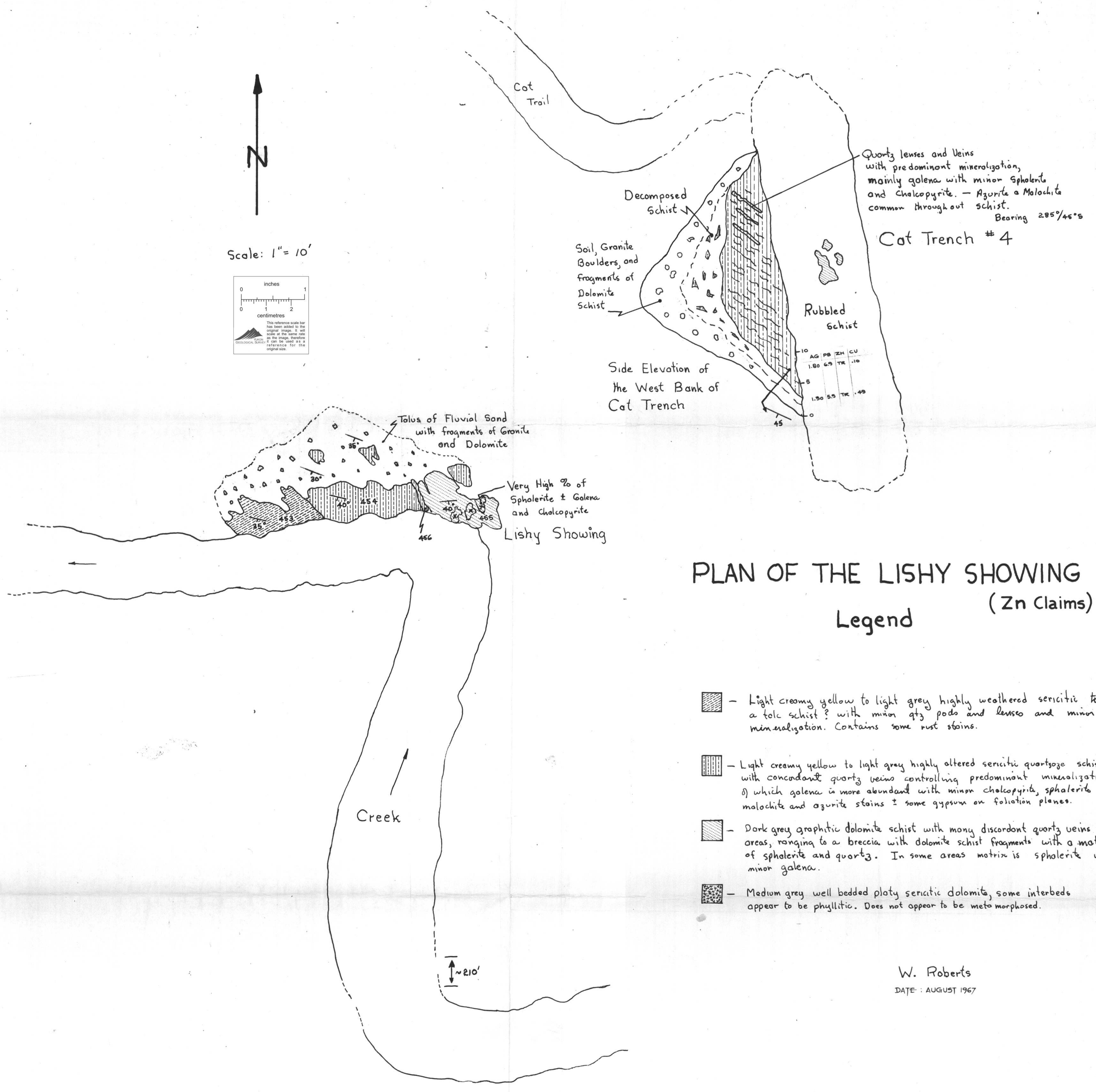
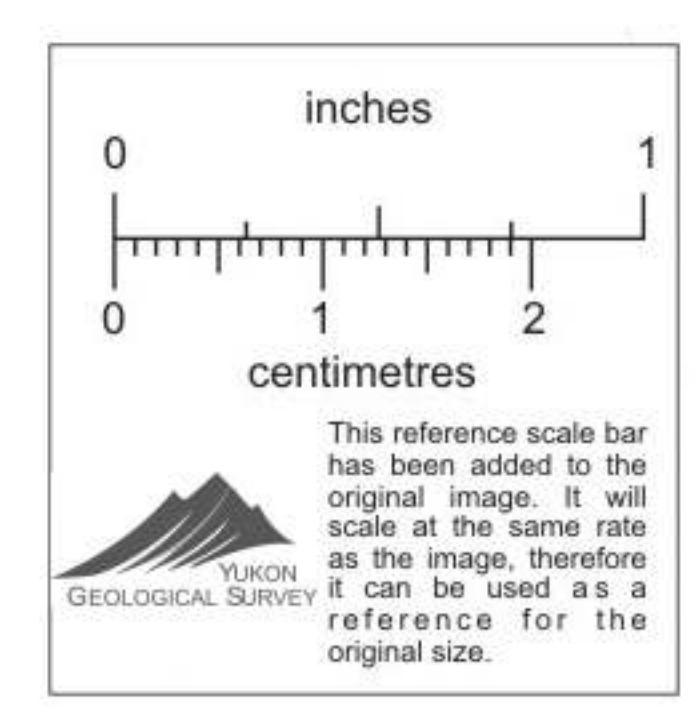

### PLAN OF THE LISHY SHOWING (Zn Claims) Legend

- Light cream yellow to light grey highly weathered sericitic to a talc schist? with minor qtz pods and lenses and minor mineralization. Contains some rust stains.
- Light cream yellow to light grey highly altered sericitic quartzose schist with concordant quartz veins controlling predominant mineralization of which galena is more abundant with minor chalcopyrite, sphalerite and malachite and azurite stains ± some gypsum on foliation planes.
- Dark grey graphitic dolomite schist with many discordant quartz veins in areas, ranging to a breccia with dolomite schist fragments with a matrix of sphalerite and quartz. In some areas matrix is sphalerite with minor galena.
- Medium grey well bedded platy sericitic dolomite, some interbeds appear to be phyllitic. Does not appear to be metamorphosed.
