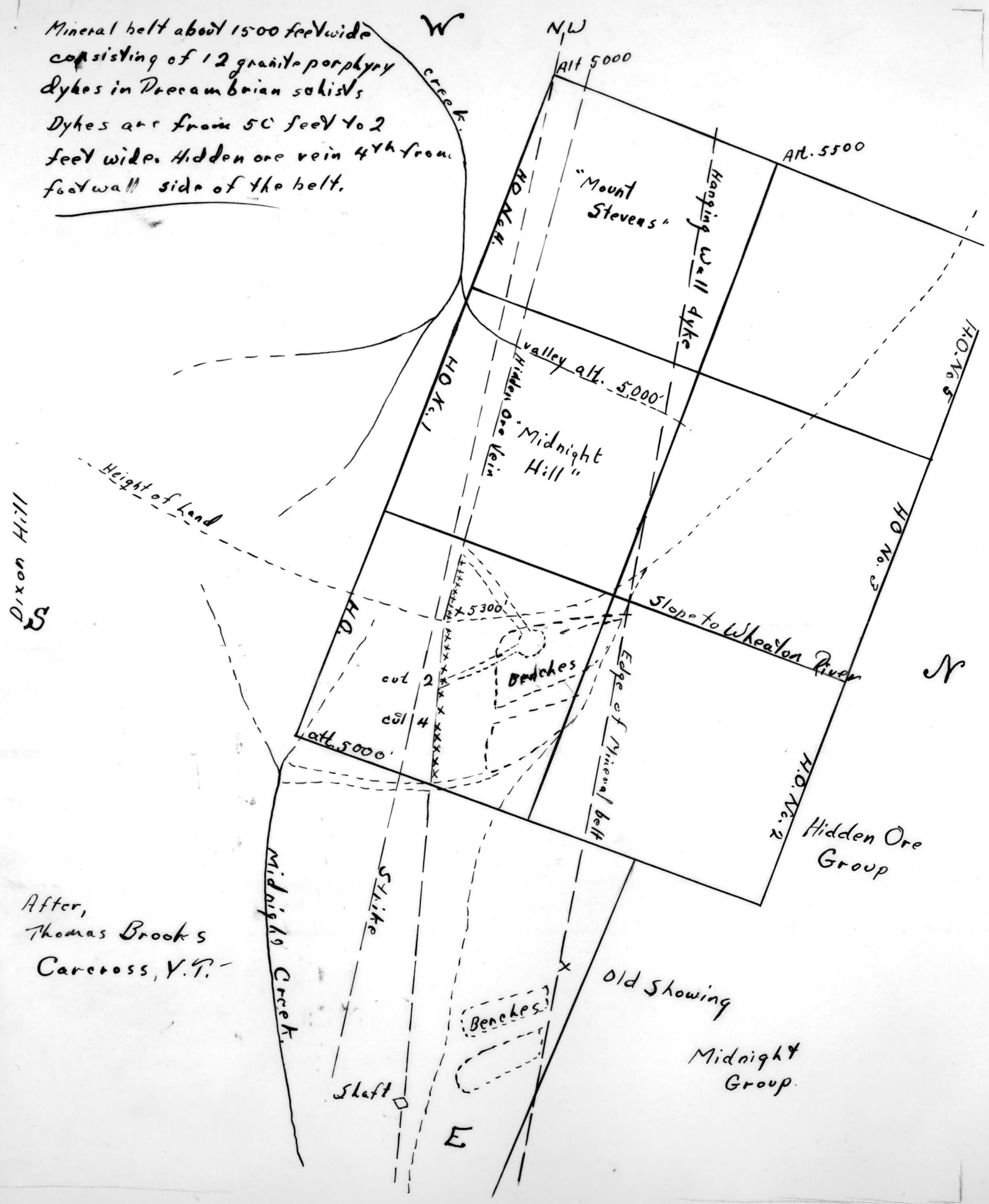


Mineral belt about 1500 feet wide
 consisting of 12 granite porphyry
 dykes in Precambrian schists
 Dykes are from 50 feet to 2
 feet wide. Hidden ore vein 4th from
 footwall side of the belt.

From Robinson to Stevens group by
 wagon road about 16 miles but
 bridge gone at Big Bend. By boat and
 trail from Carecross to Hidden Ore
 group - boat 7 miles, trail 7 miles to
 river crossing, 1 mile more to cabins
 15 miles altogether. Airplanes can
 land at Annie lake. Also at Mill-
 haven bay - both having quiet water -
 Lake Bennett generally rough.
