Risby has had his property examined by Canada Tungsten and they have declined to take the property. According to correspondence from Risby, Cantung assayed 30 samples taken as grabs from three foot intervals across strike on all showings, they did not take continuous chip or channel samples. Cantung did not take the option because of low assays and other exploration commitments.
