During August 25 and 26, CAB 73, H and 31-104 were staked. I now feel that the group has adequate coverage. In the NW corner the map shows overlap in the claims. This, however, is not the case as the final posts for claims 65 and 66 are shown with a red X.

I spent quite some time on Pete's new find north of Fox Mountain and decided not to stake it at present. The main showing approx 6x30' is very high grade but seems to have no extensions. However, lower grade material occurs approx 1000 feet away on strike.

Pete is spending 2 more days in the area to determine if there is any more. He will send word out with Bob on Wednesday if he thinks he has found enough more to warrant staking.

Pete's next camp will be to the west in the vicinity of that Beaver creek. He figures on about 5 days there and then a move to the south.

When I left yesterday there was fresh snow at 6000 feet which did not melt during the day. So, two more camps for Pete might be the end.
