Flood east of Cab group - next valley. - no specimens.
Ruly banded in field. assume that down dip
extension comes through to east slope. Flood also
found across creek - could come from south wall
of cirque. Dark altered porphyrite? intense with
pyrochlore - black staining found in same area, also near
intense large flood boulders of pyrochlore & schistite found.

W1 2 3 4 - from probable shear band, no granite c/c
seen. on east side of creek - granite outcrops across valley
to west. Locations in place but only exposures out of
overburden. Average widths about 30 feet - hard to trace.
Including flood boulders - trace for about 1000 feet. Southeastern
exposure. W4 - moly in five fractures - More pyrochlore content
in most samples than compared to main showing.

Area W55 In place - also cemented gorsan. granitic
west side of valley. Also in buff to orange weathered dolomite.
also limestone

W1W - on limestone - dolomite eastern contact of granite.
pyrochlore content higher - 20-30% in sections. main.
chrom schistite $\approx 1\% \text{ W}_3$. manganese staining.
