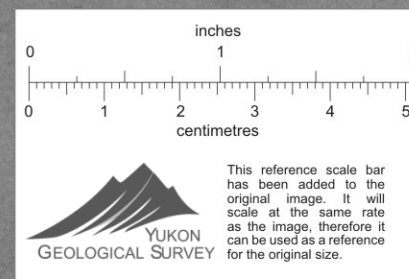


Base Map, Previous Editions 1945, 1946

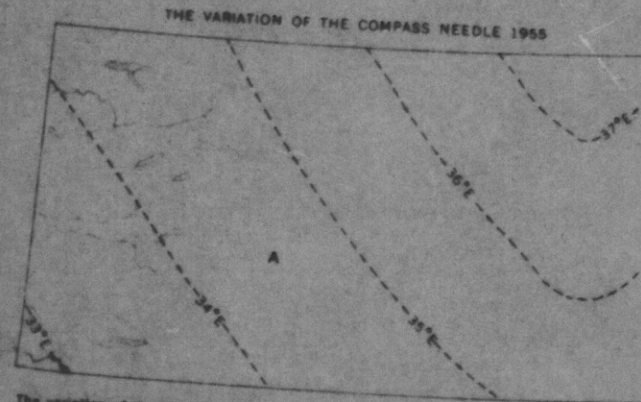

The variation of the compass needle at any place along a given line is the direction given on this diagram. This is given in minutes and seconds. These give on the neighboring diagram the true magnetic declination. The declination is between 18° E and 25° E. The direction of the compass needle is decreasing about 4.5 minutes annually.

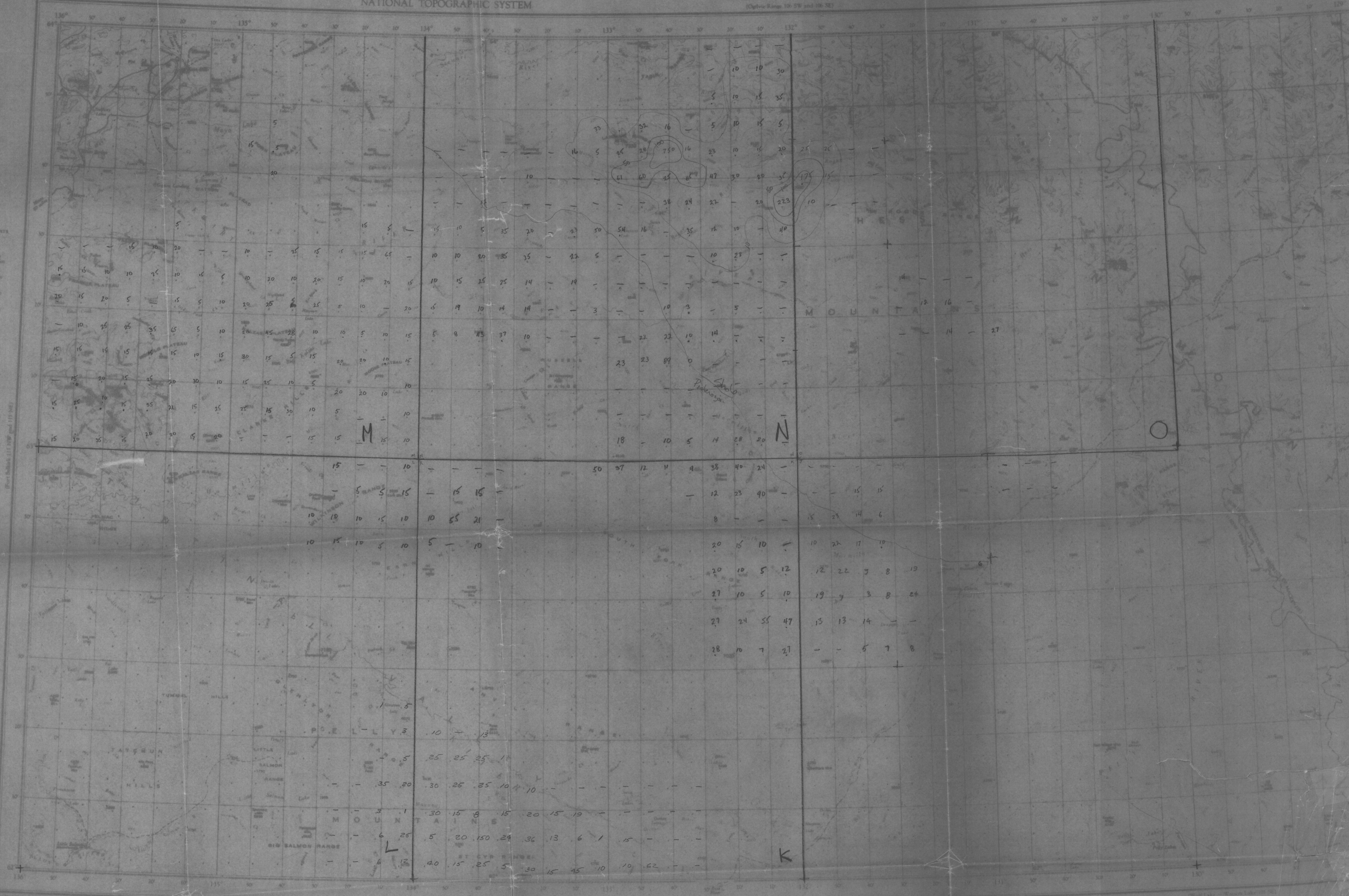
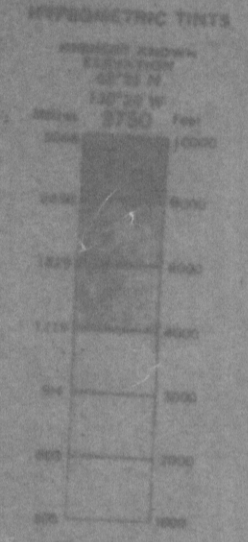

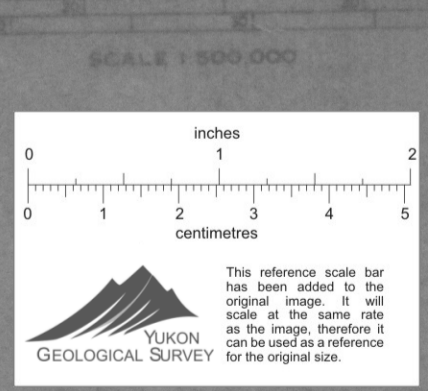
