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

Subject Induced Polarization Survey- Ace, Dea, Faro and Vangorda Areas, Y.T. Date December 20, 1966

It is reasonable to conclude from the three lines that were run over the Vangorda property that stronger chargeabilities were obtained over the ore zones than over the graphitic schists. The resistivity measurements are less reliable although line 12E indicates a definite fall-off as the survey proceeds south toward the graphitic rocks.

Because of the lack of gravity anomaly on line 12E from 5N to 11N, it is doubtful that any great thicknesses of mineralization have been missed in that area. Nonetheless, should additional drilling be ultimately required on the Vangorda property, it would be a good idea to drill one hole in the centre of the anomaly.
