Sampling has been completed on D.D. Holes A-37, A-38 and nearly completed on A-39. Drill logs for D.D.H. # A-33, 35, 37 and 38 have been mailed to our Vancouver office.

Sample chits for D.D.H. # A-36 (AFX Vangorda hole), A-37 and A-38 will be mailed to you as soon as copies are made.

The drill on line 80W drilling has been moved onto line 68W/4N (200' N of D.D.H. # A-23) and the hole, # A-45 will be collared tomorrow.

The geese & cranes have crossed our sky, probably conorting in Louisiana by now. The 3rd snowfall is on the camp grounds, approx. 8"; the temperature has been held around +10 to +15°, looks like the end of fall weather. Since the change in weather, many drillers & helpers have quit, coupled with machine breakdowns & frozen water lines have caused progress on the program to slow down considerably. At present, one machine is shutdown and one is on one shift. I believe two new crews will arrive shortly.

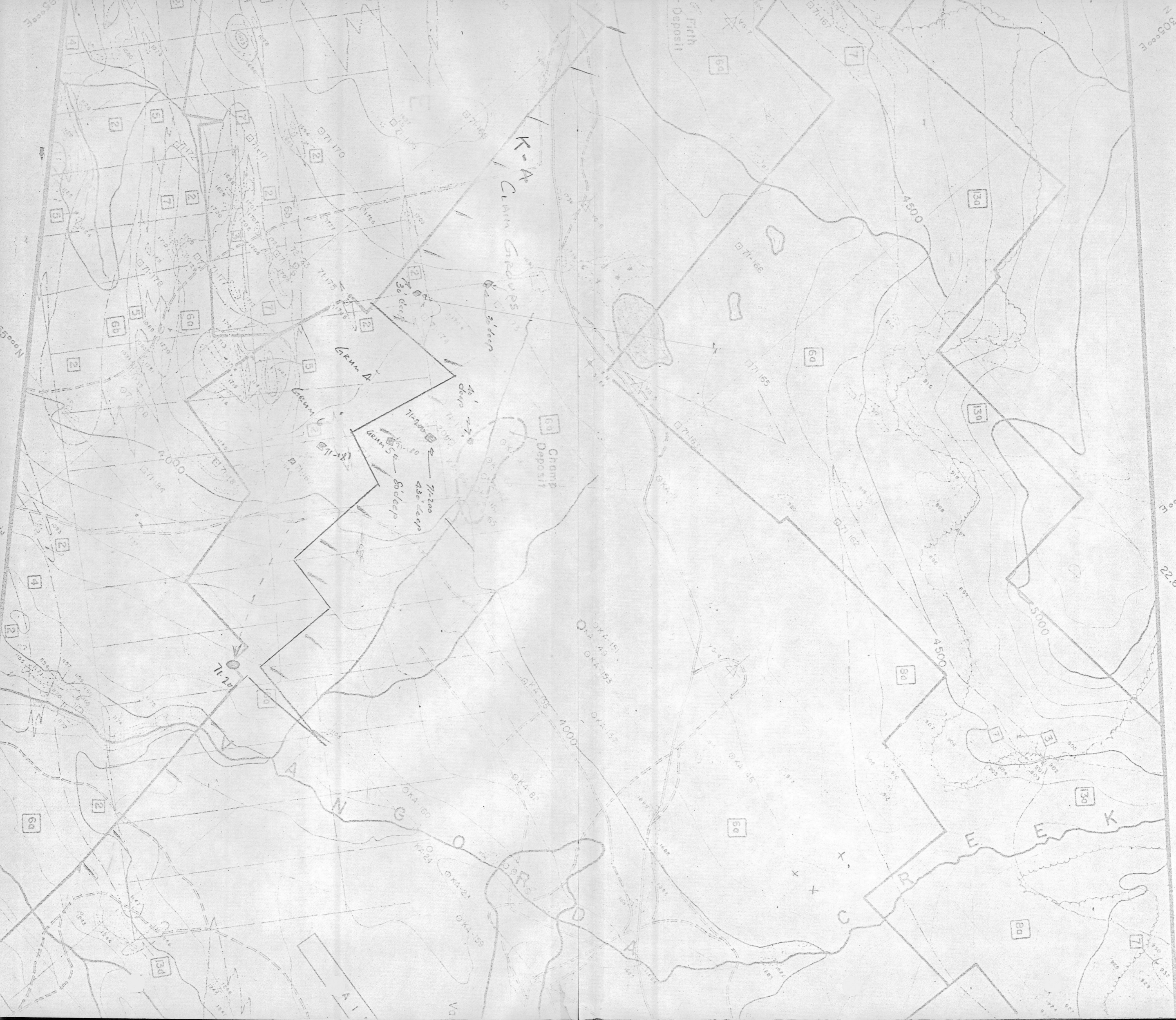

The drums for the metallurgical samples arrived yesterday. Gathering of the samples will commence when the instructions are received.

Drilling for Down at Swim Lake "A" somebody was to have started yesterday. I hope they will "hit" water on their first hole (A-4 made water before) before the spring water source dries up in this cold weather.

Results from drill intersections on line 56W over the Champ Zone have been encouraging. Let's hope line 52W results equal or surpass that in Pb-Zn-Ag mineralization.
