Dear Rod:

Over the last month, Greater Lenora has been doing some follow-up work on a group of claims we staked last year in the Yukon based on some geochim anomalies released by the GSE, in 1989.

During the follow-up work, a new surface base metal discovery was made. Original grab samples ran as high as 15 oz Ag., 12.5% Pb. and 29.6% Zn.

I personally visited the property during the latter part of August, and while the crew was cleaning the original showing for sampling, I was prospecting the talus and found another showing to the east of the original one. This new showing ran 6 oz Ag., 9.87% Pb., and 15.8% Zn over .8 meters. The original discovery was chip sampled across 3 meters, and gave a weighted average of 19 oz Ag., 13% Pb. and 18% Zn.

The latest discovery has properly been called the President zone.

All kidding aside, I believe we have made an important discovery in a good geological setting, only 7.5 miles south of the road and power line, leading to the Faro Mine. The Faro Mine is 28 air miles to the north.

We have not announced this discovery and are presently staking more ground.

We will probably be seeking a partner on the property and I thought we would offer it to you first as you have treated us so well on the Box deal.

I have sent Donald Rankin some of the information on the discovery and he will probably call you today to arrange a meeting should you wish a further follow-up.



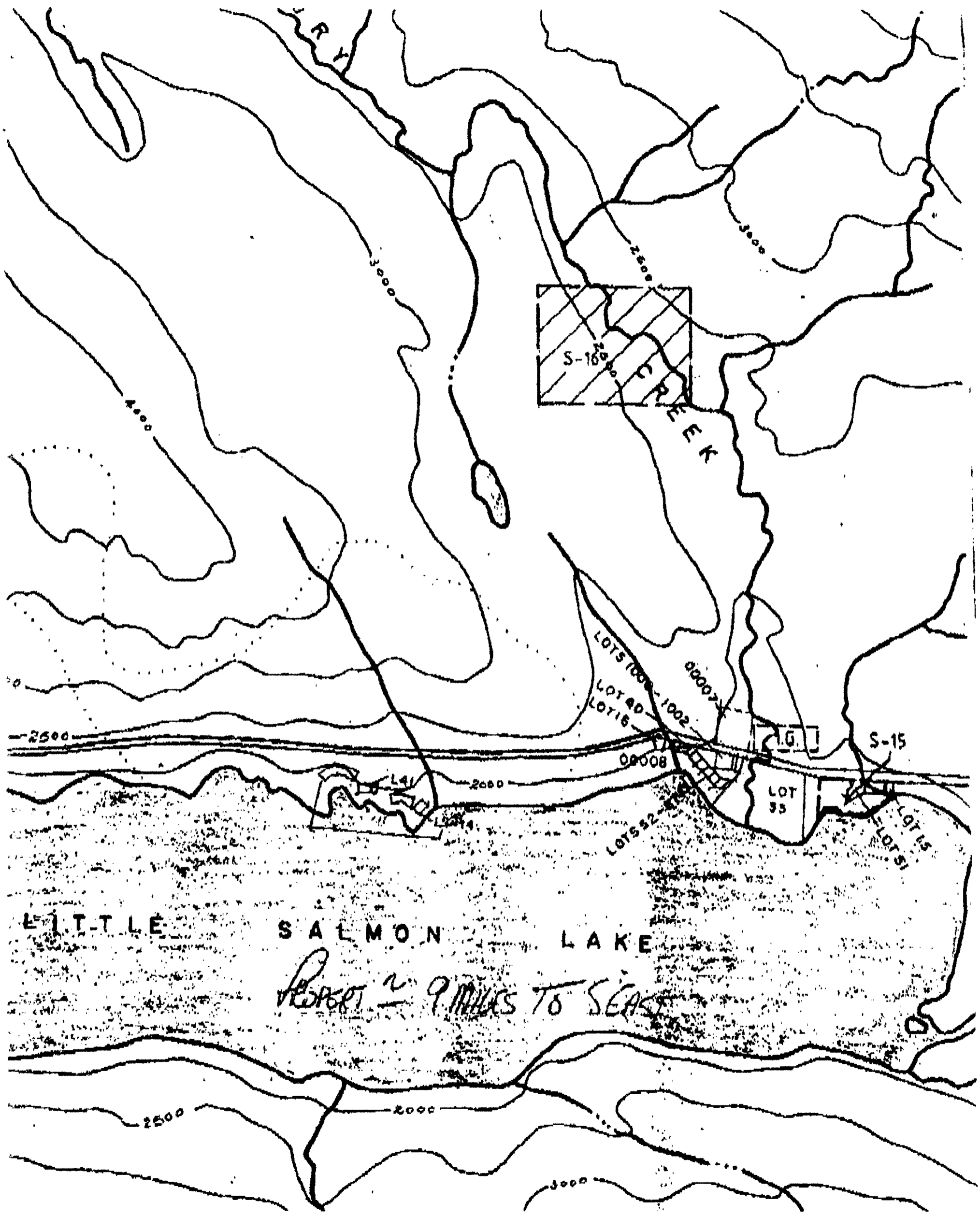

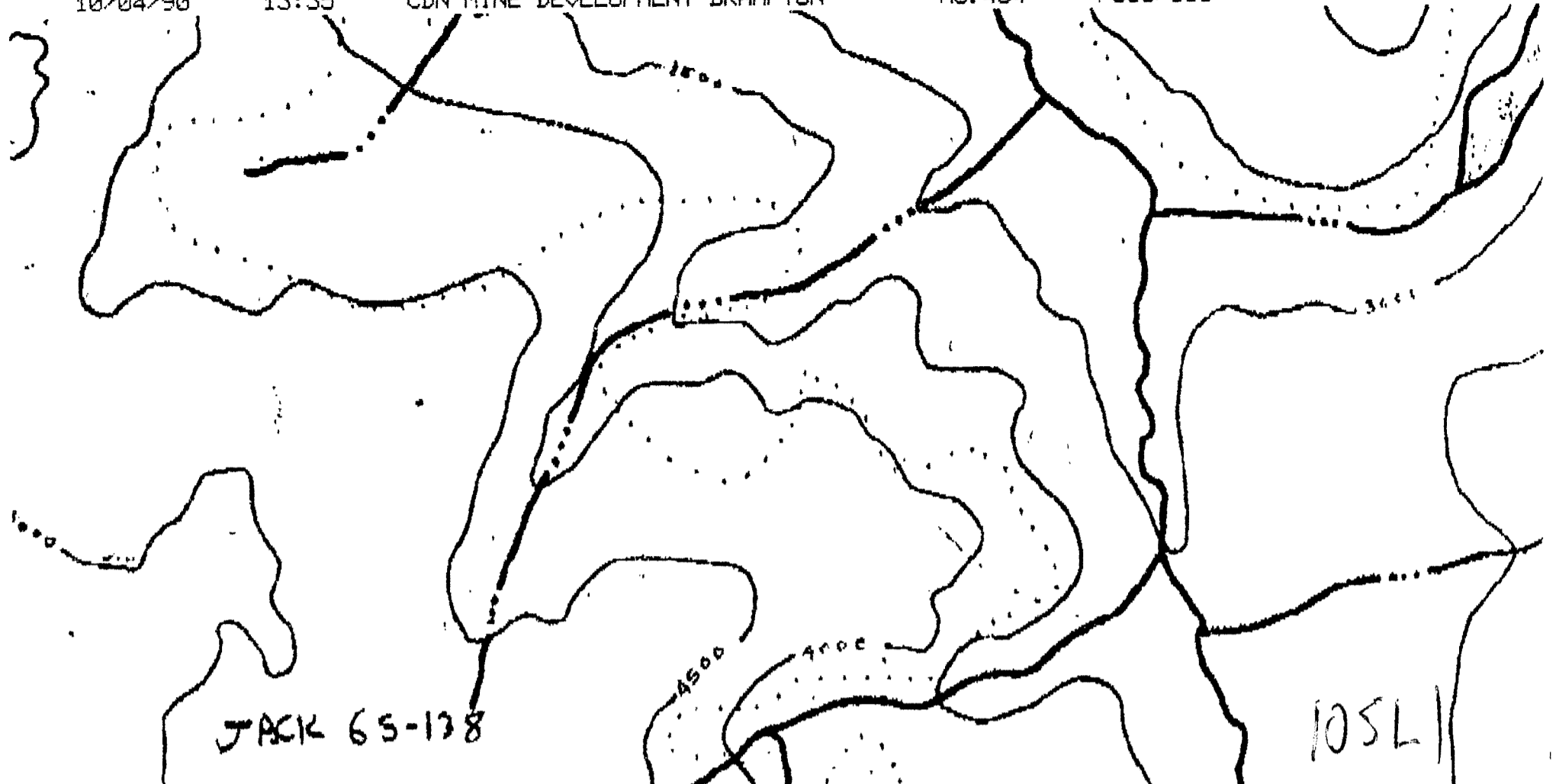

**CONCLUSIONS:**

Galena and sphalerite were found to occur at the contact of marbles with a felsic intrusive body. The occurrence of mineralization is to be at least partially responsible for the occurrence of anomalous silt samples taken down stream. Other, as yet undiscovered, skarn deposits may also have contributed to the anomalies.

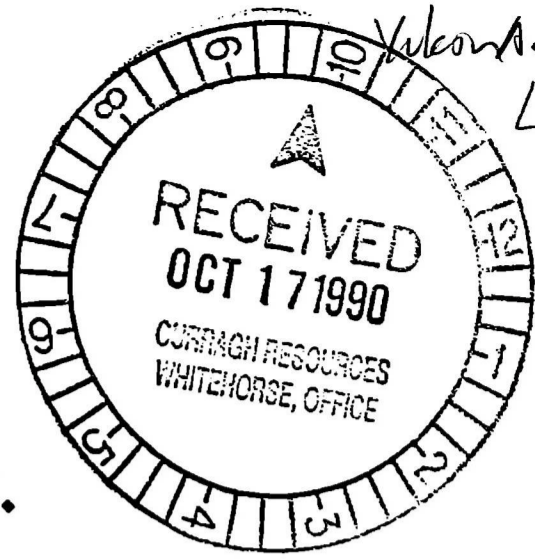
In the western portion of the property, no mineral occurrences were found to justify the anomalous silt values in the drainage. The rock types in this area are considered equivalent to those in the Faro area that contain economic stratabound Pb Zn mineralization.

This is an old showing first discovered in 1950's - newly "rediscovered" due to GSC geochemical sampling. I have spoken to Aurum geobiz about it - it is a skarn showing. Have tried to visit it but no time and now snowed in. Ray Moss tried to visit and observed only 4-6' of snow couldn't even find branches. He advises vendor talking a claim to have spent \$50K on preliminary geochemistry - trenching. Anomalies not intense - showings reported by pinch out rapidly. Not a high priority property - will snowed out.

# New mineral find near Faro

A new discovery of surface base metals in the Faro area has been made by Greater Lenora Resources.

The discovery is located 7.5 miles south of the Robert Campbell Highway adjacent to the power line leading to the Faro mine.

Aurum Geological Consultants Ltd. says the rock formations look very similar to those found at the Faro mine site, "containing economic stratabound lead and zinc

mineralization."

Where exposed, the 20-metre long discovery was chip sampled over a three metre width, with results averaging 19 oz. per ton silver, 13 per cent lead and 18 per cent zinc, according to Aurum, the company hired to do the sampling by Greater Lenora.

A second zone was chip sampled and showed results averaging 6 oz. silver, 9.9 per cent lead and 15.8 per

cent zinc over 0.8 metres.

The discovery was made by a prospecting company following up on silt samples collected as part of the Geological Survey of Canada's regional geochemistry program.

Greater Lenora has staked more ground in the area two weeks ago, and is now attempting to find a joint venture partner to help finance exploration of the property.
