Dear Greg,

At last I am putting to paper my comments concerning the Mathew Claims in the Yukon. Sorry about the delay but I have had a number of deadlines concerning reports I have been writing. With this now behind me, I can now concentrate on other matters.

Basically my feeling on the Mathew Claims is that we have a relatively large claim block which covers what I think is stratigraphy favourable for hosting massive sulphide deposits such as the MM. Very little of this land has been explored to date. In view of our relative success to date, plus the geological relationships on the property, I feel there is more to find. Consequently, I would like a program of evaluating the property as a whole. Obviously definitive is required in the areas of interest we have located to date. However, before this takes place I would like to have the remainder of the property evaluated.

I feel the best and most cost effective means to do this would be through an airborne magnetometer-EM survey. From this a number of conductors should be delineated. These could be evaluated through a series of small grids using ground geophysics, soil sampling and geological mapping. These could then be prioritized and evaluated through either trenching or diamond drilling. Since the Ketz River Mine is located only 5 km to the east and the terrain does not appear to be severe, road access to the property could be easily attained. This would significantly reduce exploration costs in the future.


