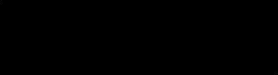
RE: REPROCESSING OF MAGNETIC DATA TO HELP WITH DANIELE'S MINERAL POTENTIAL STUDY

Warner Miles (see below) has just completed reprocessing of aeromagnetic data in map sheets 116A, 116B, 116G, 116H. This draping and levelling is supposed to significantly improve the resolution of the data, which was flown at a 2 km line spacing.

GSC is planning to undertake more of this reprocessing, but has many competing priorities. Warner would be happy to do map sheet 116I for you to help with Daniele's project, if he can get a letter of support that indicates that this is a priority job. I am sure you can get the results as a digital file that will integrate with the rest of Daniele's work.

If you want to follow up on this, please send a request to Joan Tod (Warner's boss, see below), I suggest with a copy to Warner who will be doing the work.


