I have decided on the following to meet our needs for the field season:

1. A consulting contract with Danièle Héon for two months. She is asking for a rate of \$425/day plus expenses, which seems reasonable given that she knows our procedures inside out and can hit the ground running. I have had the contract drawn up for a maximum of \$25,000, which is the maximum that we can sole source without going to the Minister for approval. She will be back in town at the end of June, and can work for two months (July-August). As I indicated to you, there may be considerable resistance from Contract Services if they perceive this to be an employment contract (paragraph 7 of the Contracting Directive specifically states that departments are not authorised to enter into employment contracts).
2. A casual hire of Kel Sax for three months. She is a geological engineer with many years experience conducting field exploration programs and prospecting. I have sent the paperwork to Glenis, although she indicated that she has not done a direct casual hire before. Kel is currently working on a contract with Aurora Geosciences but can start on July 4th.

The plan is to have Danièle and Kel work together in North Yukon, then Kel would work with Anna at Ddhaw Grow and Daniele would work at Snafu/Tarfu.

I will hold the competition in September for the two term positions. I think the terms should run to March 31, 2003, to coincide with the end of the fiscal year.
