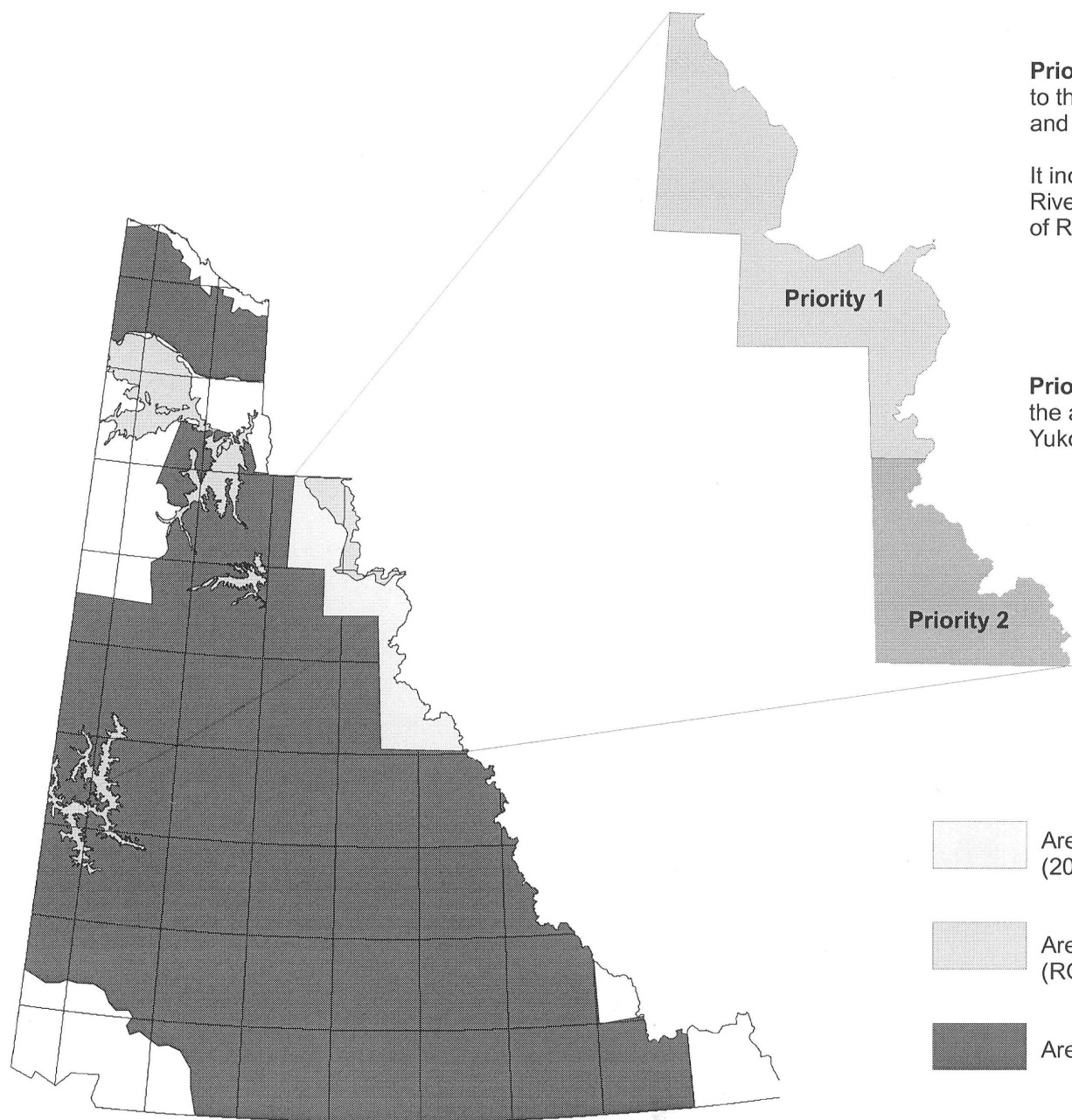


Proposed RGS Survey March 2001




Priority 1 area (11,706 km²) extends south to the 65th parallel, northeast to Peel River, and east to the Yukon border.


It includes the entire Yukon portion of Peel River Preserve, and represents completion of RGS surveys on the following map sheets:

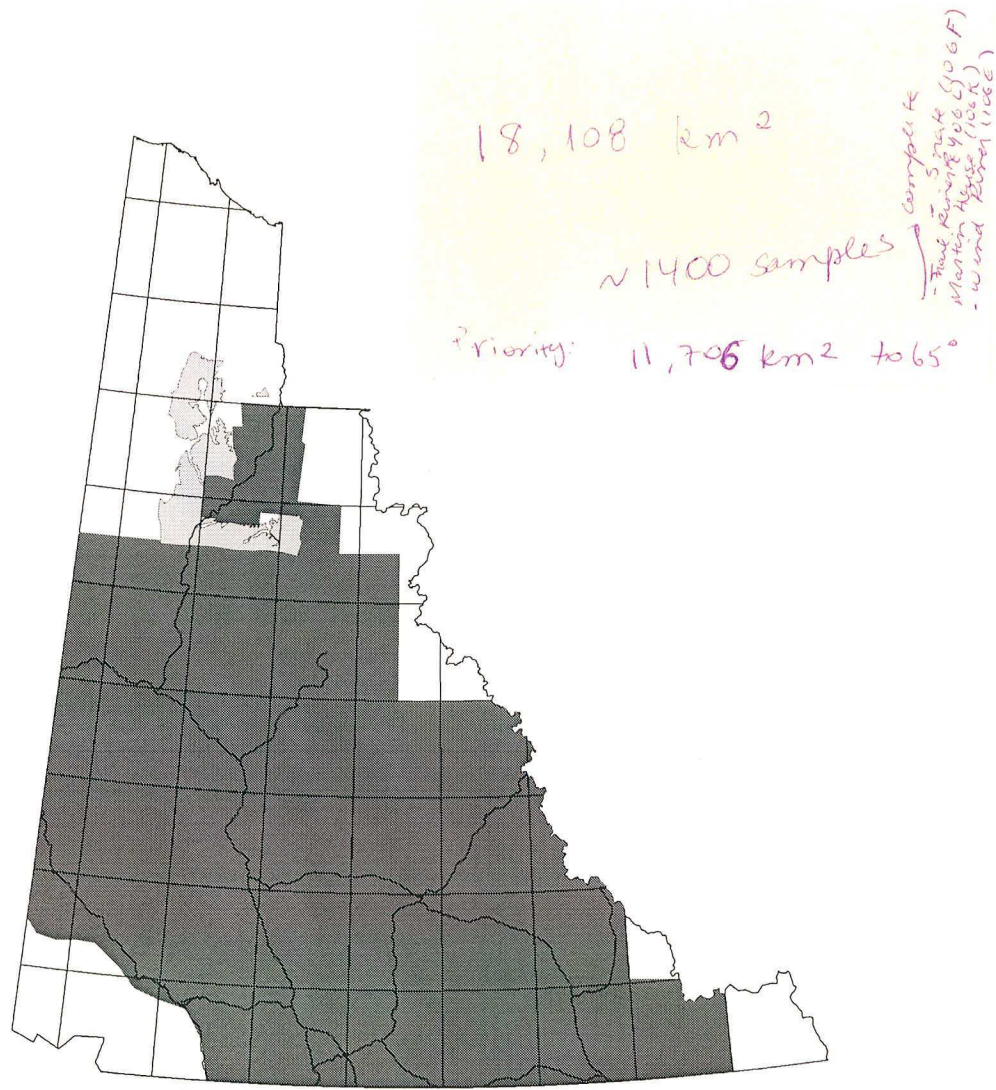
- Snake River (106F)
- Trail River (106 L)
- Martin House (106 K)
- Wind River (106 E)

Priority 2 area (6,402 km²) extends south to the area of existing RGS surveys, east to the Yukon Border, and north to the 65th parallel.

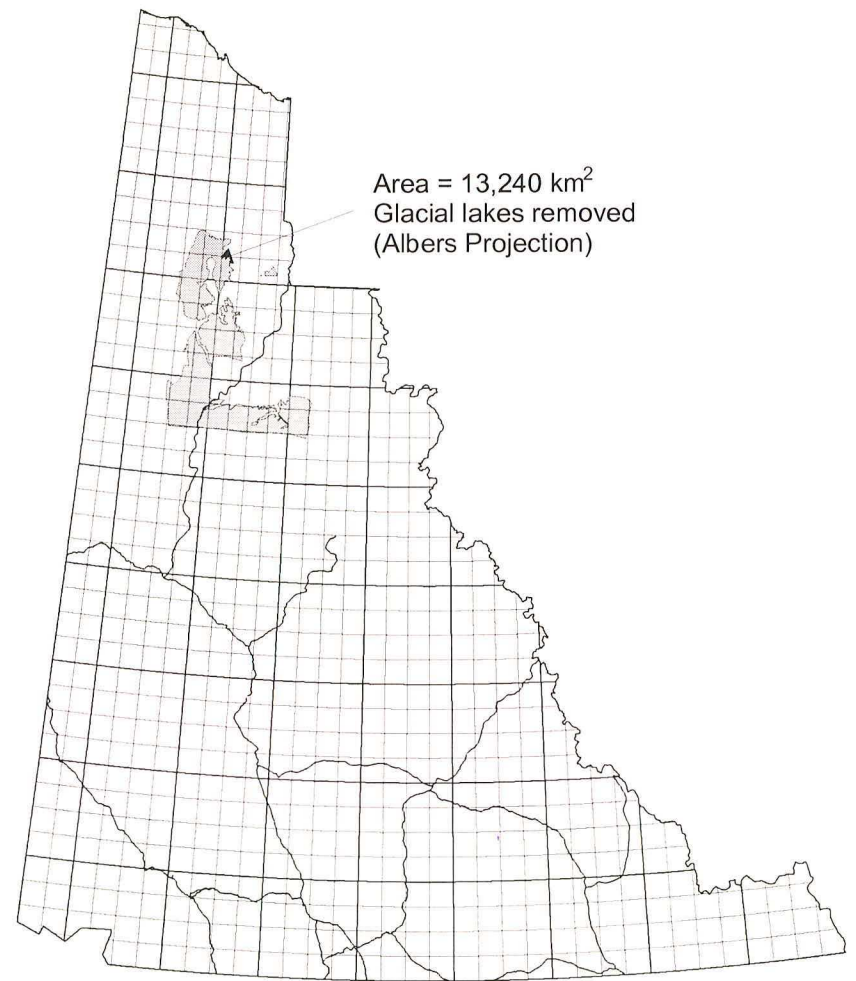
 Area of proposed RGS survey (2001 - 2002)

 Area of thick till cover (RGS not appropriate)

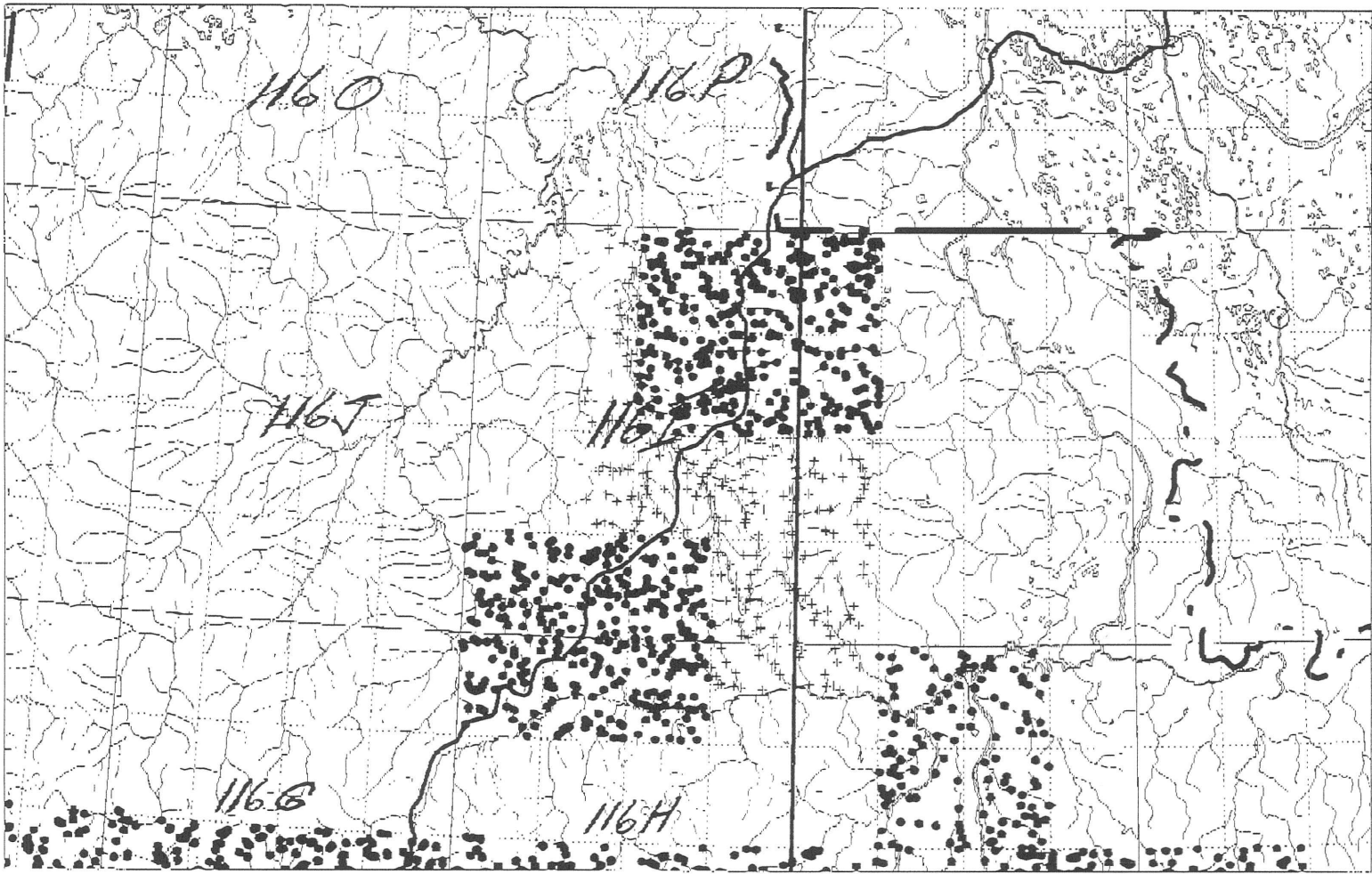
 Areas of existing RGS surveys



Map of Yukon showing area of proposed RGS survey (pink), 1:50,000 NTS sheets, and roads.

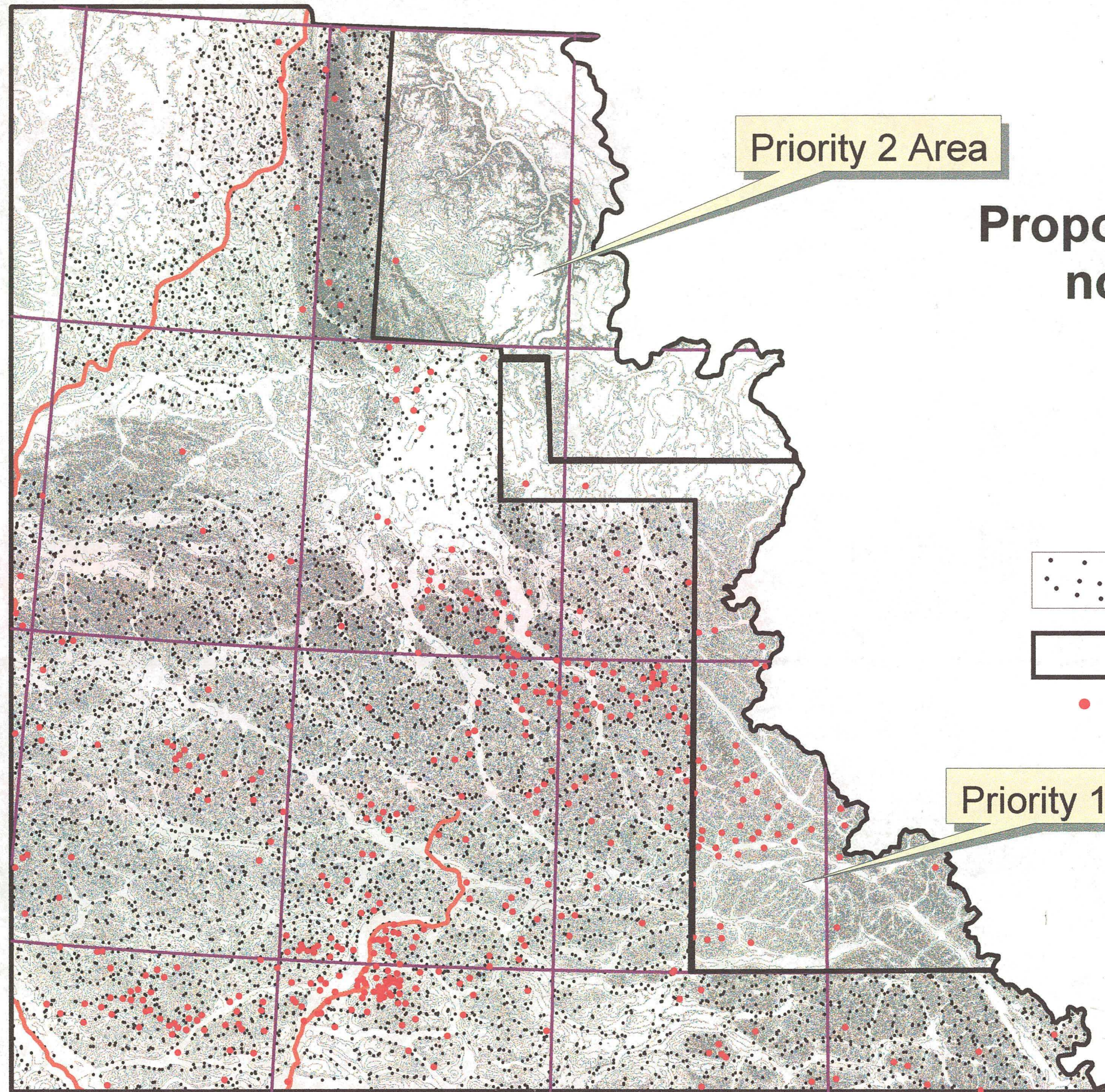

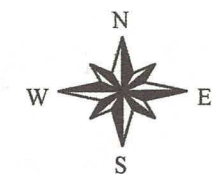



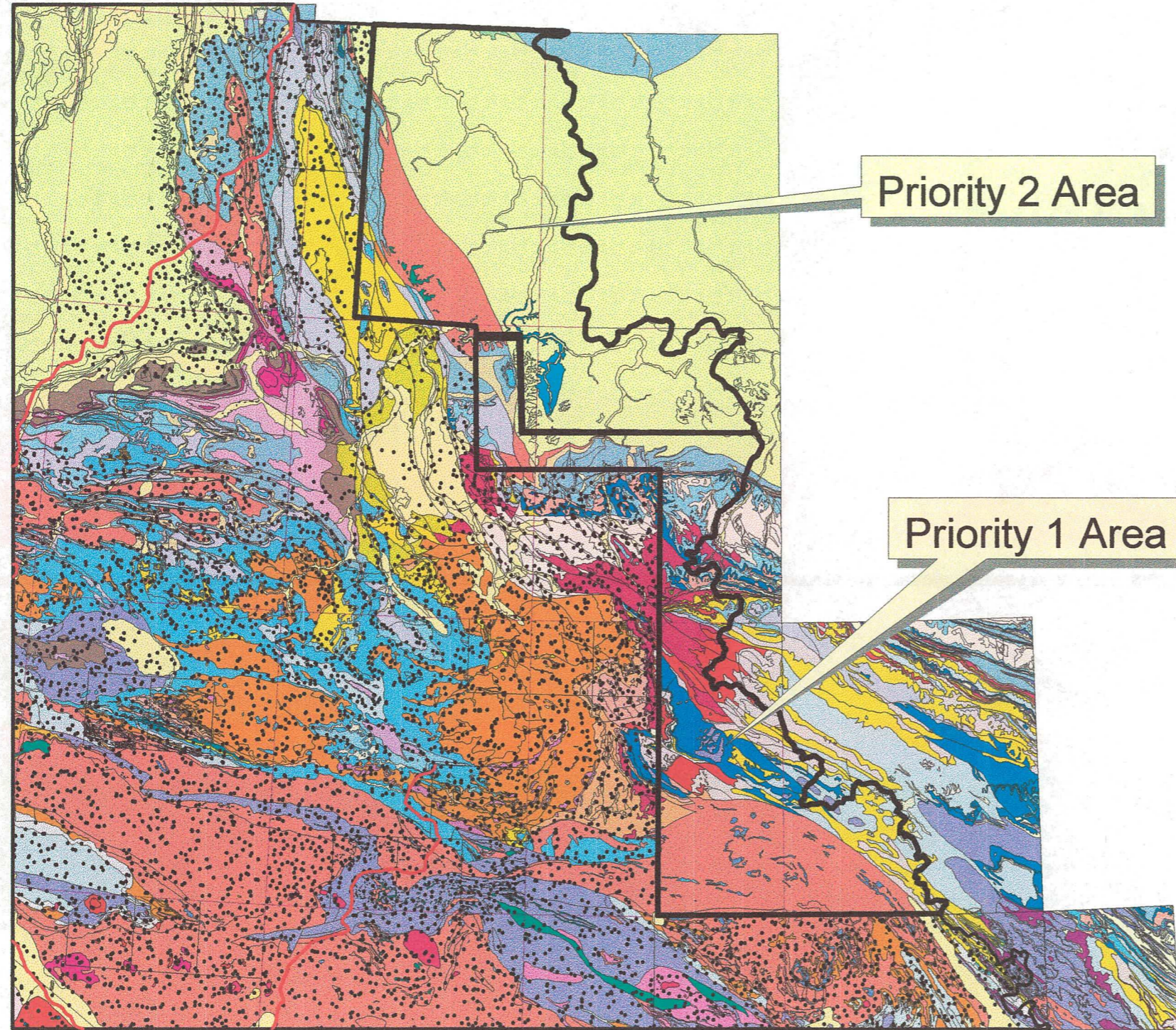
