Portable Infrared Mineral Analyzer (PIMA) analyses

Two samples were examined by PetraScience Consultants Inc.: JH98-1 and JH98-2. JH98-1 is a sample of rock from Pearl creek on the Wolf property. The rock has a white coating on it, as do most rocks in this creek. The white coating was examined and identified as silica. JH98-2 is a sample of yellow weathering ?felsic metavolcanic rock from the Tree property which contains amygdules filled by a fine-grained grey mineral. The amygdules were examined and found to consist of muscovite and minor sulphate.
