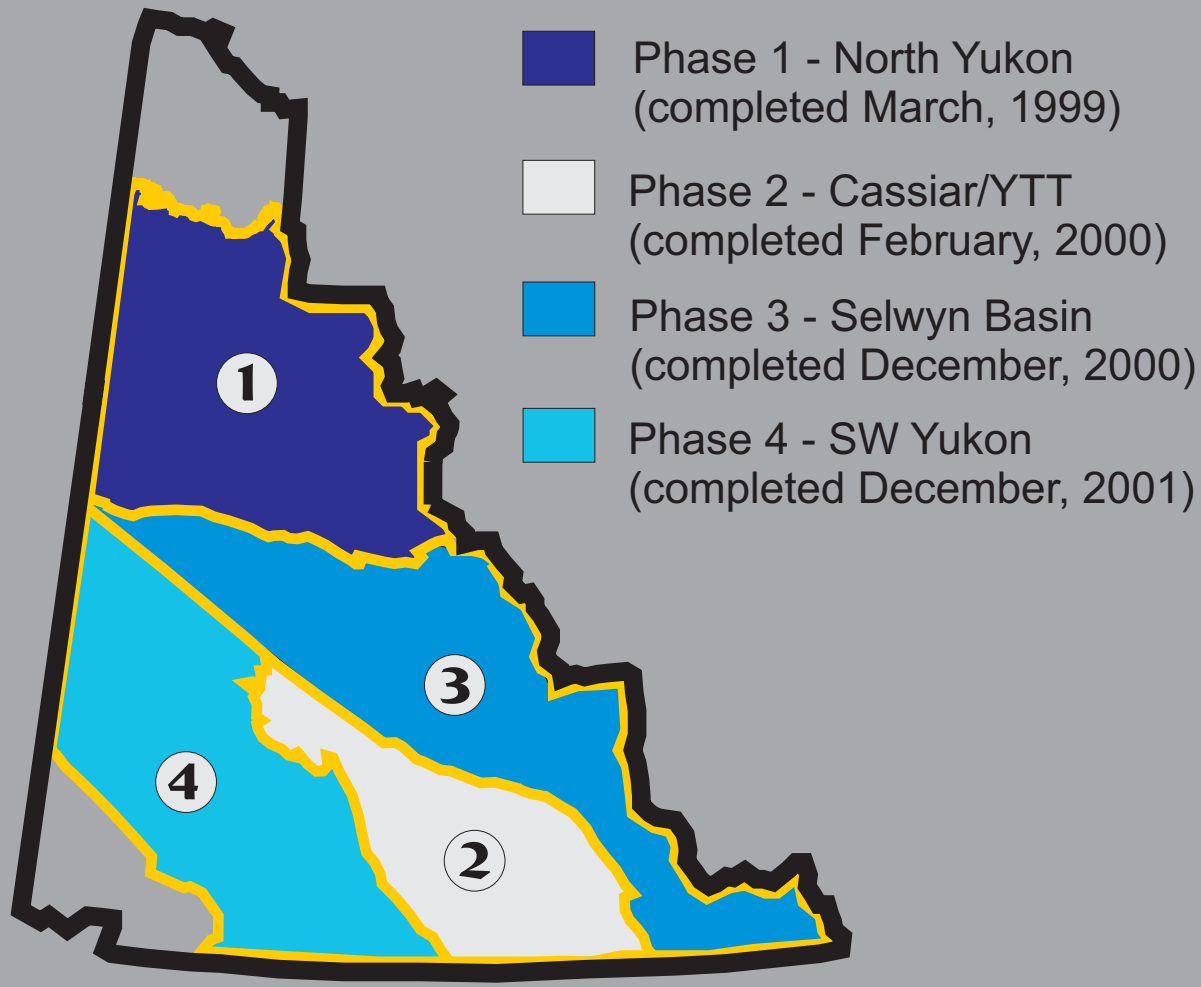
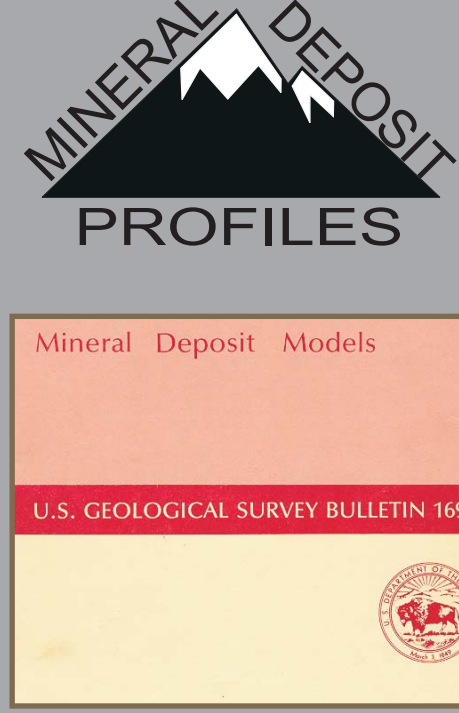


Purpose and Scope of Regional Mineral Assessments: The assessments were designed to assist in large scale land use planning exercises by providing information on the potential for undiscovered mineral deposits.

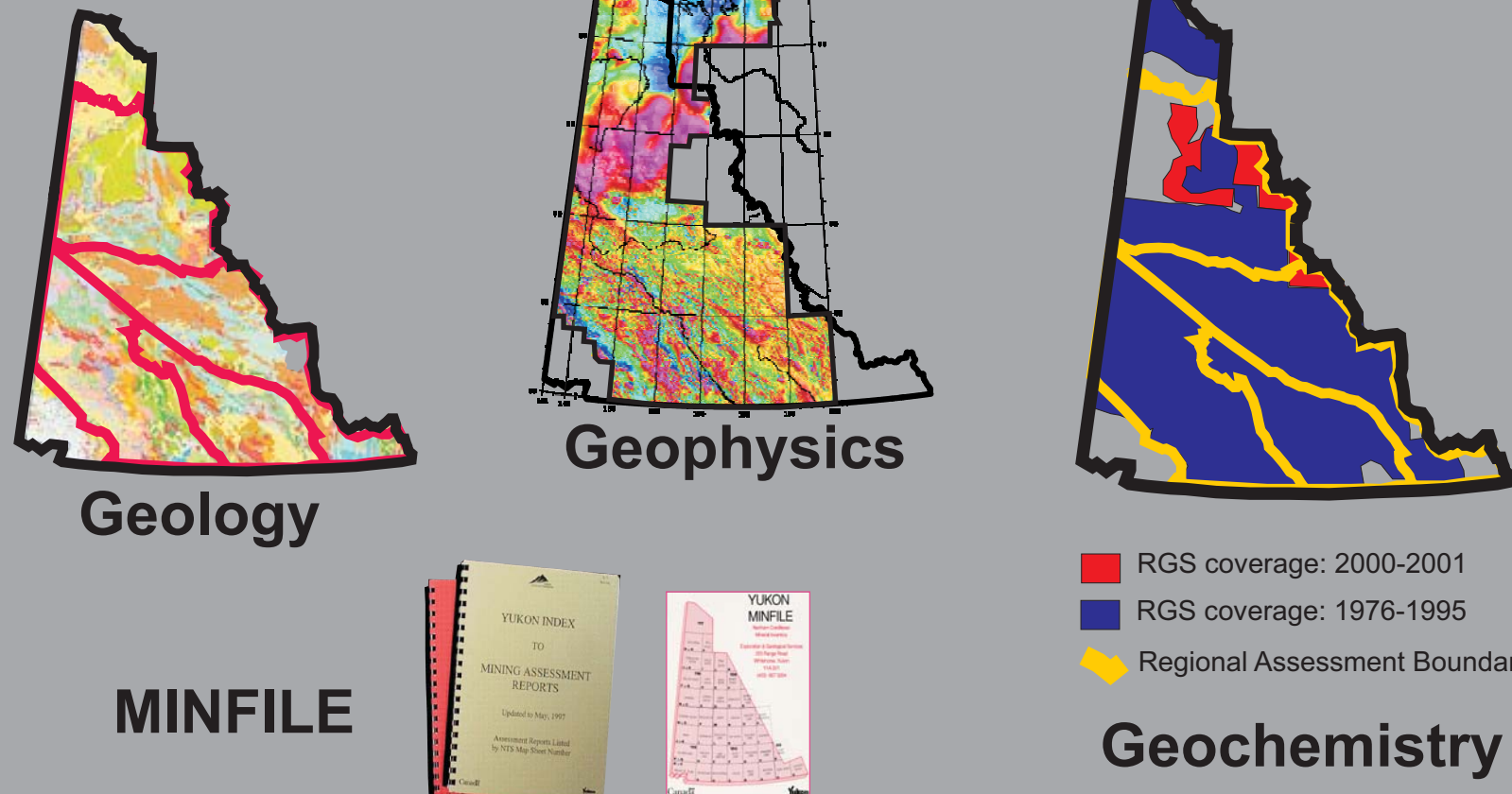
Mineral Assessment Phases



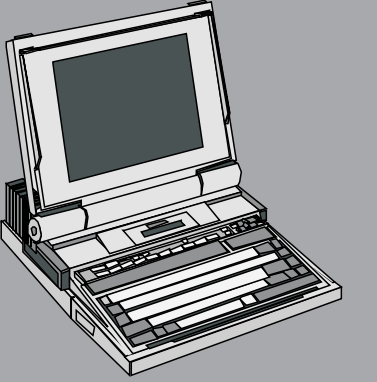
Assessments are based on deposit models developed by the USGS, the BCGS and the YGS



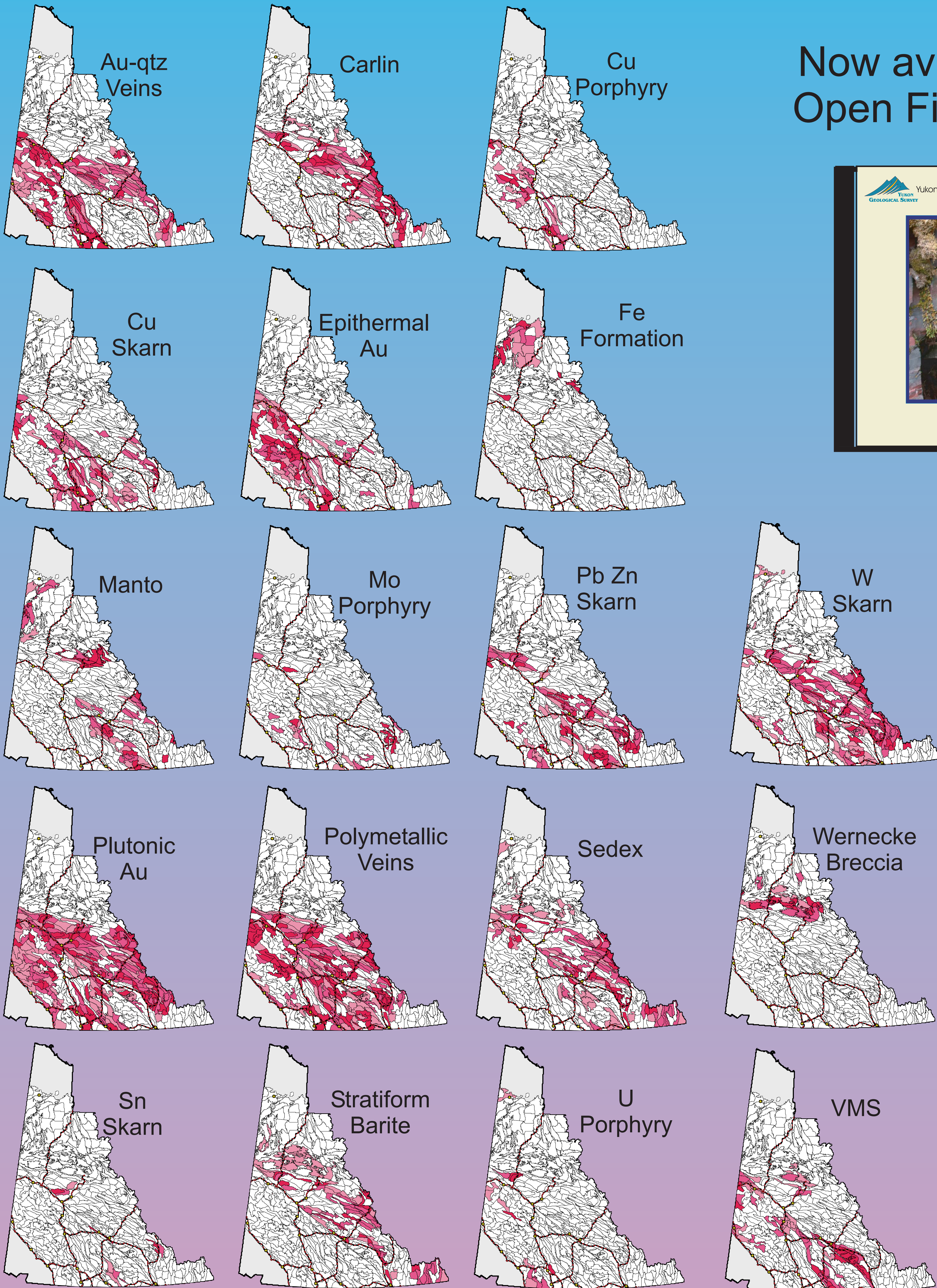
Assessments are done by a panel of experts using all available geological, geochemical, geophysical and MINFILE data



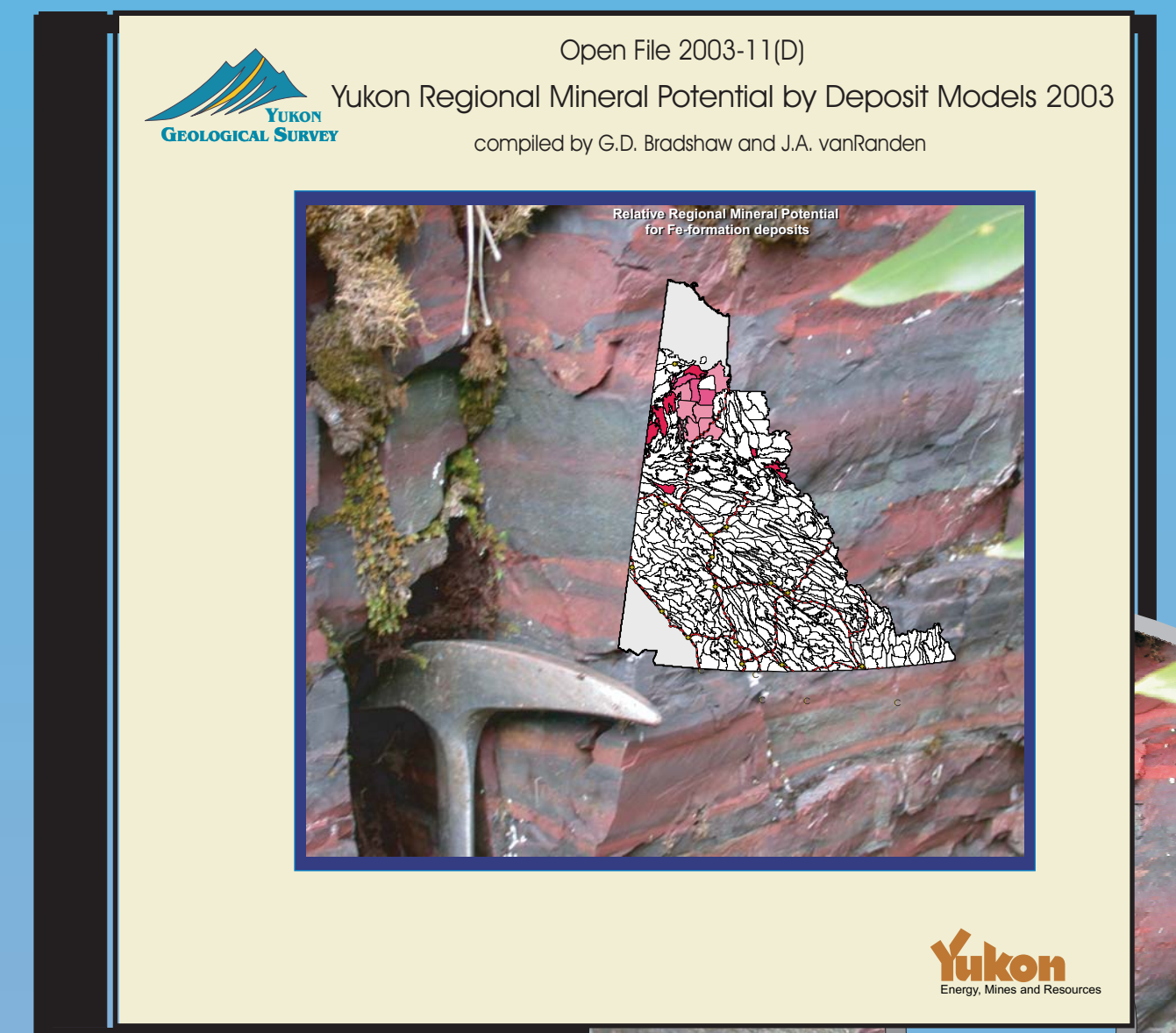
Data provided by the expert panel is entered into a simulator, which produces a score for each tract for each deposit model



Limitations of Regional Mineral Assessments: These studies were based on the geological knowledge and data available at the time of the assessments and are limited by the quality and quantity of this data. Mineral potential rankings are subject to change with additional data and improved geological knowledge.
